Adkisson says agriculture scientists lowest paid faculty in country. By SCOTT PENDELTON. Agriculture scientists should do number one work for number one pay, said Dr. Perry Adkisson, vice-president for agriculture and renewable resources. Adkisson spoke to an audience of more than 1,000 at the biennial conference of the Texas Agricultural Extension Service. "The work we do is just as important," he later said, referring to the fact that scientists in other colleges are generally paid more than in the college of agriculture. The situation isn't unique to A&M. Adkisson pointed out that agriculture is one of the lowest paid faculties in the country. However, he said that A&M is among the top ten highest paying universities in the country for agriculture scientists. "We're competitive," Adkisson said. The difference in pay doesn't affect the quality of work done either here or nationally. "The discrepancy is not that big," Adkisson said. "It's a problem of professional image." Other faculties look down on agriculture as being of inferior intellectual quality, he said. Adkisson isn't advocating any particular action toward higher pay. He merely wants to create awareness of the problem. But he thinks agriculture scientists could help by improving their image. Being more professional in their work and in their contact with the public would result in an increase in professional status. This might result in a corresponding increase in pay, he said.
