**Ali brings president a message**

MOSCOW — Muhammad Ali, hugged and kissed by Leonid Brezhnev, will carry a message from the Soviet president to the White House, his aides said.

The Soviet leader met with the former world heavyweight champion Monday in the Kremlin for 15 minutes, which surprised U.S. diplomats because of the strain in Soviet-U.S. relations.

The fighter has received a warm welcome in Moscow, said an aide who said he arrived Monday. He put on an "outburst Tuesday."

An aide to Ali said he believed Brezhnev gave Ali a message, which the aide declined to discuss.

Asked if it was intended for President Carter, the aide said "I'm not sure from a head of state and you have to assume that it should be passed to a head of state."

Ali hinted earlier he might do something important to take the White House soon, he said.

He said Brezhnev made an unofficial ambassador for peace to the United States.

Ali, subdued in his dark suit, said he and Brezhnev had changed "hugs and kisses."

"This is the biggest honor ever had in my life," he said.

An aide said the boxer returned to his hotel suite afterward and almost an hour in disbelief had met the Soviet leader.

Ali reported Brezhnev was healthy.

"If you're worried about health, from what I saw you have to contend with him for a while," he said. "He is in shape."

Ali was invited to the Union by a state sports commission but the fighter's aide said Brezhnev meeting had been arranged for almost three months.

Obviously pleased with the attention, Ali returned the courteous praise for the Soviet leader.

"I've never seen a man so peaceful and I've traveled over the world," he said.

Ali has been careful to make marks, being equally positive about the United States.

"I love my country," he said. "I think it's the best in the world. I don't want to live in no other America. I love America."

**New ring association is planned**

NEW ORLEANS — The United States Boxing Association designed to promote U.S. boxing and reduce the chance of their rankings, may be formed August convention.

Emile Bruneau, chairman of Louisiana State Athletic Commission and a former World Boxing Association president, Monday officials from boxing organizations regulatory agencies throughout the country have been invited to the convention of the new U.S.B.A. held in New Orleans Aug. 15-17.

The commission has a \$2,500 to sponsor the meeting.

Bruneau, who has been boxing for almost 60 years, said the objective of the group would be to rank U.S. boxers and try to emphasize from international to those from the United States.

The WBA and WBC are concerned with boxers from America and the Orient and seem to care about the U.S. said.

Asked if he thought the would help prevent such as a television boxing scandal last year, Bruneau replied, "I think exactly correct."

ABC-TV was forced to stop telecasts of the U.S. Championship Boxing Tournament in April because of allegations that records were rigged and that had to pay kickbacks to get tournament.

"If we're going to have a boxing association that would eliminate the problem," he said. "Of course, we'd have rules and regulations by which they'd have to abide."

He refused to criticize promoter Don King, who was the scandal-marred tournament said "I don't look at boxing the same eyes as those fellows."

"I look at boxing as the most petitive sport that there is. I think that all fighters should be judged on their abilities and their affiliations."

Bruneau, whose commission oversees the Muhammad Ali-Spinks rematch at the Louisiana Superdome in September, has received good response for the new group.

He said the convention would be called off unless at least 50 agree to attend, but he expected to reach the goal.
