## Firemen working after fiery strike

MEMPHIS, Tenn. — A firefighters' strike marked by more than five million dollars of fiery destruction in this city ended Tuesday as union firemen returned to fire stations.  
Apparently satisfied for now with the promise by city officials to resume contract talks in good faith, about one-third of the firefighters who joined the strike reported for duty.  
"Everything seems to be smooth and calm and to my knowledge there are no pickets at any stations," Fire Director Robert Walker said Tuesday morning. The remaining firemen were to report Wednesday and Thursday.  
Union members met Monday night and agreed by voice vote to comply with an injunction issued earlier in the day by Chancellor Robert Hoffmann that ordered the firemen to man the city's 51 fire stations at the morning shift change for 450 of the union's 1,400 members.  
"The men are going back reluctantly," said Kuhron Huddleston, union president. "They are negotiating in good faith but they are not throwing away any of their gains."  
Huddleston, president of the International Association of Fire Fighters, has said he refused to discuss their demands to establish a wage differential in a federal mediator, who has no power to impose a settlement on either side.  
Mayor Wyeth Chandler's officials would attempt to resolve their differences with the union before summoning a mediator.  
"It's my impression we are down and see if we can resolve differences on our own," he said. "If we cannot well, it can bring in a federal mediator."  
A total of 350 fires were during the strike. Fire Chief Robert Walker said
