

# Supreme Court's decision on abuse hearings delayed

An assistant state attorney general says further clarification will be needed for a U.S. Supreme Court decision requiring child abuse hearings within 24-hours of reported in-

The 24-hour requirement was part of a wider ruling by a special three-judge federal court in Houston which declared various sections of the Texas Family Code unconstitutional. Attorney General John Hill had sought a higher court order to prevent the state from complying with the lower court order pending

The Supreme Court Monday re fused to grant a stay in the case until it has gone through normal legal apeal channels.

Assistant Attorney General David Young said the state's complaint about the lower court order was pased on a requirement of hearings for parents within 24 hours of the
