first class session. The new classes are making macrame pot slings; basket-making; needlepoint; crochet; macrame; an-tique refinishing, and pottery. The classes in lathe and silkscreen are al-

One hundred and thirty-three people have participated in the courses offered so far this summer.

"Things seem to be going pretty well," said Karen Zantow, assistant program coordinator for the craft shop. "Everyone seems pretty happy," she said.

The craft shop offered 23 classes at the beginning of the first summer

session. Of those, nine were cancel led because not enough people enrolled. Six more courses finished this week. The craft shop is located downstairs in the northeast corner

of the MSC. A variety of hand and power tools can be used upon presentation of a student 1D card. To use some wood-working tools students must first pass a written and practical test. Any student, faculty, and staff

member of Texas A&M may enroll in the craft shop courses. Most courses have a small lab fee. Students must provide their own materials, but the craft shop will supply all tools. A crafts fair is planned for August 2 and 3 to be held outdoors between


