Coastal mountain stop tropical storm

TUXPAN, Mexico — After grazing the world's leading vanilla-producing region in eastern Mexico, Tropical Storm Bess battered harmlessly against coastal mountains and lost much of its strength.

The storm, which grew out of a tropical depression in the Gulf of Mexico last week, veered south of its expected touchdown point in Tuxpan Monday night and instead whipped across lush citrus groves and farmland.

A spokesman for the Gulf Hurricane Forecasting Center said the storm hit land late Monday night with winds of about 62 miles an hour.

"The storm lost force quickly when it made a landfall and I doubt if there was much damage," the spokesman said.

He said the landfall was made between the Cazonas and Tecolutla rivers, the world's leading vanilla-producing region, about 150 miles northeast of Mexico City and 100 miles south of Brownsville, Texas.

The storm then battered mountains along the eastern coast shoreline.

Bess began moving southward Sunday away from the coast, which is still recovering from heavy flooding triggered by Tropical Storm Amelia in July.

Two other tropical depressions appeared in the Atlantic, threatening to develop into storms.

One was located about 300 miles east of Barbados, the other 1,100 miles west of the coast.

Hurricane forecasters said conditions were favorable for strengthening of the two new depressions in the Atlantic, but it was too early to tell how they would develop.

Rhodesian racial laws slated to be updated

SALISBURY, Rhodesia — The interim government said Tuesday it will change racial laws to end some of Rhodesia's visible forms of segregation in public facilities — such as movies, cafes, toilets, swimming pools and hotels.

"One of the greatest things that has happened to this country has started now," Bishop Abel Muzorewa, a black member of the government's ruling executive council, said upon emerging from a council meeting.

"The executive council wishes to make it clear that the removal of racial discrimination is an ongoing exercise which will continue until all discrimination has been removed."

But there were indications the black population would be disappointed.

A black ministry of education employee spending his lunch with Prime Minister Ian Smith said the resolutions were "absolute rubbish."

"Nothing about these schools, residential areas or distribution of land."

When asked about these institutionalized discriminations, Muzorewa said, "We are in the process now of doing these things."

The decisions reached by the racial executive council were confined to the more visible areas of segregation. Drafting them will start immediately, a government statement said.

The most significant decision appeared to be that owners of places — including hotels, restaurants, cafes, bars, swimming pools, cinemas, theaters — will not have the right to bar admission to a person of a particular color.
