


Jensen out for season United Press International

DENVER — The Denver Broncos Tuesday said fullback Jim Jen-sen, who had been making an impressive bid for a starting job, would be lost for the 1978 season due to a knee injury suffered last week against the Houston Oilers.

Coach Red Miller said Jensen's injury orginally was believed to be minor but tests Monday determined ligament damage to the 226-pounder's left knee was more severe than expected. He said Jensen underwent surgery later Monday.

Jensen, acquired from the Dallas Cowboys last season, reported to camp 10 pounds lighter than he was a year ago, and had improved his speed. He had a best clocking of 4.4 in the 40-yard dash compared to last season's timing of 4.6.

In the Broncos' 17-12 Saturday night preseason triumph over Hous-ton, Jensen scored Denver's first touchdown. His 10 carries were more than any other Bronco running back and he outgained every Denver rusher except quarterback Norris Weese, who rambled for 77 yards.
