'Pilgrim Pope' takes last journey in ceremonial funeral procession

VATICAN CITY — Paul VI, the "Pilgrim Pope" who visited six continents during his 15-year reign, took a last brief journey sealed in a plain wood casket Wednesday from the summer palace where he died to St. Peter's Basilica, his final resting place.

An estimated 200,000 persons lined the 15-mile route from the Castel Gandolfo summer palace to the Vatican. The trip took one hour and 38 minutes.

Watching over the cortege along the route were about 5,000 policemen, honor guards and anti-terrorist agents mobilized by Italian authorities to prevent incidents, clear the way for the cortege and salute its passing.

The cortege passed into Rome through the ancient Aurelian Wall and stopped for five minutes in the cobblestoned square in front of St.

John Lateran Basilica.

An army honor guard sounded trumpet flourishes as the cortege entered and left St. John's Square, where about 10,000 persons gathered to watch.

At dusk the Pope's cortege entered St. Peter's Square, thronged with mourners. Hundreds of choristers, chanting a litany, escorted the pope's body up the broad stairs into the church.

Motorcycle deaths increase since helmet law repealed

AUSTIN — The president of an insurance company information service Tuesday said states that have repealed mandatory use of motorcycle crash helmets have experienced a radical increase in fatal motorcycle accidents.

Jerry Johns, president of Southwestern Insurance Information Service, said a national report indicated that motorcycle deaths have increased 32.8 percent in the 22 states that have repealed helmet use laws in the past two years.
