

Rain, cold don't stop raft party

BOISE, Idaho — President Carter and his family embarked on a three-day whitewater excursion down the "River of No Return" Tuesday — the first leg of an 89-mile wilderness adventure.

Rain was falling and temperatures were cool as the party set off on rubber rafts down the middle fork of the Salmon River, situated amid spectacular mountain scenery. Before long, the president took some time out for fishing at Saltwater Flat.

Fishermen in the presidential party caught three cut-throat trout during the stop, which took place after an hour and a half of running the rapids through rocks and bumpy going in the two-foot-deep river.

As Carter prepared to board the raft for the first time at Indian Creek landing, he told reporters, "I feel great already." Then he snapped a picture of them "to remind me of what I'm leaving behind."

The presidential party flew to their starting point from Boise, Idaho, this morning accompanied by a retinue of guides, forest rangers, Secret Service agents and reporters.

The president, in high spirits, moved up his departure time nearly an hour to get an early start at shooting the rapids.

"I'm really looking forward to going down the Middle Fork," Carter said on his arrival in Boise Monday. "I think we will probably stick with the raft, but, if they give me a chance, I might try a canoe. I am an old canoeist and kayaker."

Tuesday was Carter's longest day on the wild river, and, although the water was low, there was plenty of excitement and beautiful scenery to engross him.

The president was accompanied in his rubber raft by his wife, Rosalynn, his daughter, Amy, 10, whom he described as "an outstanding swimmer," and two of his three sons, Jack, 31, and Chip, 25, both of whom have taken canoe trips on rugged rivers in western Georgia with their father.

Also in the presidential party was Interior Secretary Cecil Andrus and his wife, Andrus, a former Idaho governor, was the prime mover in getting Carter to take the raft ride, an excursion he has made three times.

Other tourists were not being inconvenienced by Carter's presence on the river. Permits must be obtained far in advance, and officials decided that all those who have been granted permits for the same days as the president would be allowed to take their trips on schedule.

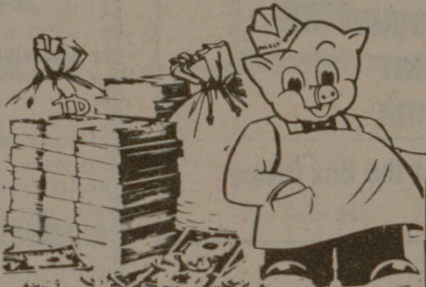
