C of C to hold energy seminar

The Bryan-College Station Chamber of Commerce will sponsor "Planergy, Inc.," an energy conservation seminar, Wednesday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:15 p.m. at the Texas A&M University Rudder Center.

The seminar, presented in cooperation with the Governor's Office of Energy Resources and the Texas Public Utility Commission, will focus on how to conserve energy without sacrificing comfort or profits.

The Bryan-College Station seminar is one of two dozen seminars being held this year in 20 cities around the state as part of the State Energy Conservation Program. The program's goal is to achieve a 5 percent statewide decrease in energy consumption by 1980.

"This is a first-time event," Larry Matheson, assistant manager of the Bryan-College Station Chamber of Commerce, said. "It's a form of public information on energy conservation for businesses and the general public."

Alvin C. Askew, administrative assistant for energy to Texas Gov. Dolph Briscoe, will keynote the meeting at 9 a.m. Immediately following Askew's address, participants will break into six concurrent workshops designed specifically for local governments, utilities, lending institutions, retail businesses, home builders, architects, contractors, public school officials and new commercial builders.

Registration for the energy seminar will begin at 8:30 a.m. on the fifth floor of Rudder Tower. Admission is free and the public is welcome.

Czech 127 offered despite cancellations

Beginning Czech 127 will be offered this fall.

Woody Smith, lecturer in the Czech and Modern Language department, said that the course for beginning Czech students has not been canceled despite the notices that were sent out to some students saying that it has been.

"I don't know why these notices have been sent out," Smith said, "but beginning Czech will definitely still be offered."

Smith and Czech Club president Pat Cernoch have been working to increase enrollment in beginning Czech so that it will continue to be offered in the future.

"There are lots of people of Czech origin on campus, but for some reason they don't take Czech," Smith said. He said that the language is useful, especially because there are so many Czech communities and Czech speakers in this area.

Smith stressed that the most rewarding part of taking Czech is the summer study program students are able to take during the summer in Czechoslovakia. Those who attend spend six weeks at Charles University studying the language and the country. Students pay only their transportation to and from Czechoslovakia. Tuition, room and board, and travel within the country are all provided by the Czechoslovak Foreign Institute. Any students who finish beginning Czech or the equivalent are able to attend.

Students in the Czech program and Czech Club participate in area ethnic festivals, Smith said. Last year the Czech Club sponsored two polka dances in Snook.

"This year we hope to have some Czech films as well as participate in local Czech festivals," Smith said.

MSC Finance Center gives no financial aid

Many students are trying to pick up financial aid — loans, grants and scholarships — in the Student Finance Center in the MSC 217. Those students are looking for their money in the wrong office.

The Student Finance Center acts as the banker for student organizations and takes orders for graduation announcements, Fay Yeates, the center's supervisor, said.

"We don't give out financial aid," Yeates said.

Students who need to pick up their loans, grants and scholarships can do so today through Wednesday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. at the Rudder Tower cashier's window.

Holders of Hinson-Hazelwood health profession and national loans first must report to the Student Financial Aid Office, the floor of the Y.M.C.A. Building, sign the loan note, Robert Logan, director of Student Financial Aid, said.

Holders of state student income grants also must report to Student Financial Aid before picking their grants at the Rudder Tower cashier's window, Logan said.
