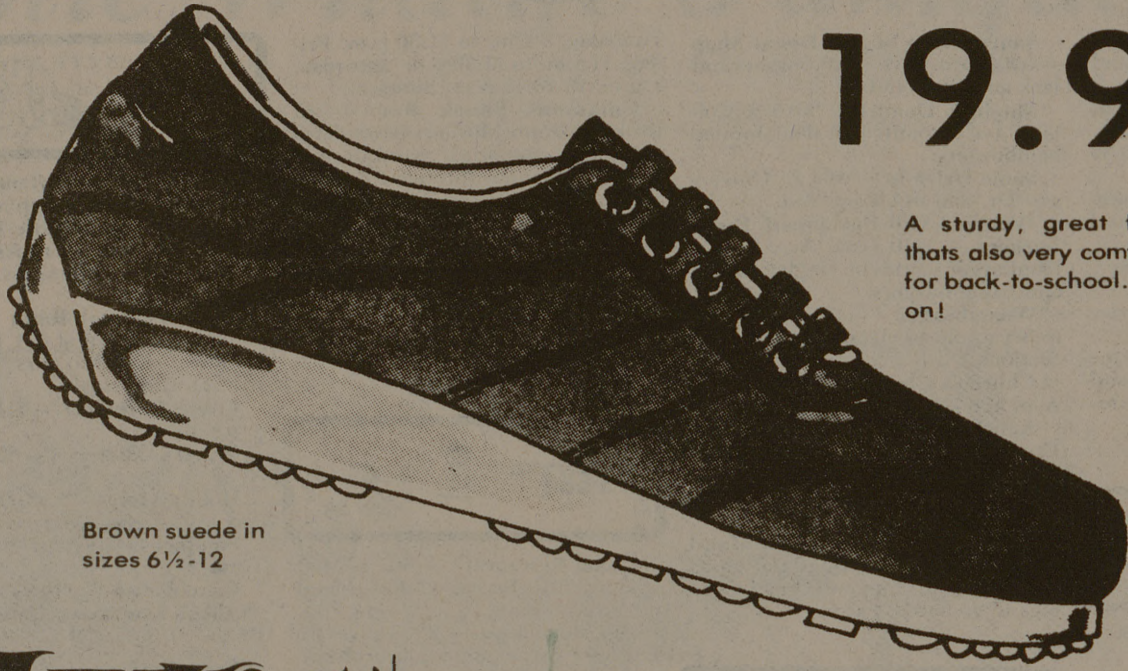

Aggie Cinema still big entertainment bargain

A dollar will buy admission to any
one of the 50-odd movies to be
presented by the MSC Aggie Cine-
ma this fall.

Aggie Cinema will kick-off the fall
semester movie season Thursday
with "Dr. Strangelove," a black
comedy dealing with a world gone
crazy and headed toward nuclear de-
struction. Directed by Stanley Kub-
rick ("2001," "A Clockwork
Orange," "Barry Lyndon"), the film
stars Peter Sellers and George C.
Scott. Tickets for the 8 p.m. and 10
p.m. shows are available at the MSC
Box Office.

Burt Reynolds, Pink Panther,
Humphrey Bogart and Neil Simon
fans will have a chance to see their
heroes in action this fall when Aggie
Cinema presents a series of film
festivals featuring these favorites.

Burt Reynolds flicks will head the
film festival series beginning Sept. 8
and 9. Reynolds films include
"Smokey and the Bandit," "The
Longest Yard," "Semi-Tough" and
"Deliverance."

The Pink Panther will sneak across
the screen Oct. 20 and 21, in "The
Pink Panther," "A Shot in the
Dark," "Return of the Pink Panther,"

"The Pink Panther Strikes Again"
and several Pink Panther short films
and feature cartoons.

Nostalgia buffs should set aside
the evenings of Nov. 7 and 8 for the
Humphrey Bogart film festival. The
featured classics include "The Mal-
tese Falcon," "In a Lonely Place,"
"The Treasure of Sierra Madre"
and "The Caine Mutiny."

The following week will showcase
Neil Simon hits including, "Murder
by Death" and "Barefoot in the
Park" on Nov. 17 and 18.

Aggie Cinema is not the only cam-
pus group presenting films this fall.

The MSC Cepheid Variable
Committee will sponsor science fic-
tion and mystery films for those Ag-
gies who crave futuristic or super-
natural movies.

On Nov. 30, Cepheid Variable will
present a night of terrifying tales
based on the stories of Edgar Allan
Poe. Two films, starring Vincent
Price, will feature Poe stories "The
Tell-tale Heart," "The Pit and the
Pendulum," "The Cask of Amontil-
lado," "Sphinx" and "Masque of the
Red Death." Other Cepheid Vari-
able films include "Dark Star," Oct.
7, in Rudder Auditorium, "Animal
Farm," Oct. 12, in Rudder Theatre,
and "Doc Savage," Oct. 26, in Rudder
Theatre.

For those looking for something
more sophisticated in films, the Arts
Committee will present "A Night of

Fun and Animation," Oct. 13, at
p.m. in the Basement Coffee House.
The evening promises to be one of
sheer delight as Mel Brooks, Barbra
and the Unbelievable Bugs
Malacapalacapo explore the world
of experimental fantasy.

Cepheid Variable and Arts Commit-
tee films vary. Interested students

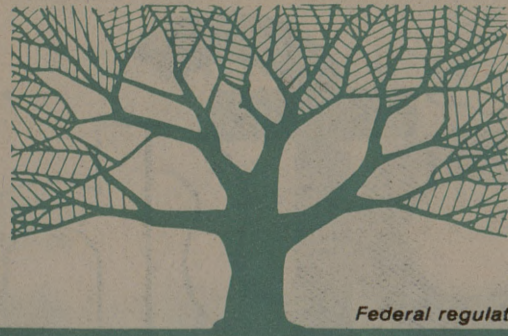
