'The defense, especially the secondary, is coming together," Holtz said Monday. "That is more than can

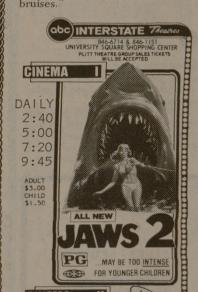
be expected after a scrimmage."
