BUENA PARK, Calif. — The exact distance — close to 300 feet — may be disputed, but no one argued that it was not a long way to fall without a parachute.

Stuntman Dar Robinson broke the free fall record by dropping, without a parachute, from a hovering helicopter Saturday. Robinson, 31, fell unhurt onto a 30-foot airbag in a field at Knotts Berry Farm, an amusement precisely 286.1 feet. However, Robinson said the surveyors had made a mistake and the fall should be listed as 311 feet.

Whichever it was, it beat the old mark of 232 feet set by stuntman A.J. Bakunas during filming of the Burt Reynolds movie "Hooper."

This was the third time Robinson attempted the jump. The other jumps were canceled because of poor wind conditions.

Jerry Grooms, a consulting engi-er for the Lafayette Parish com-mity of 3,000, said the state Ith department assured resits that while the worms might insightly, they posed no health

Hopefully, we've got the prob-vesolved," Grooms said Sun-"Today, I didn't see any when I ecked on it

Grooms said complaints began day morning. Health officers called immediately and diagosed the problem as larvae that ad gotten through filters and into water system

A heavy dose of chlorine was plied to the water system Friday orning and another was applied riday afternoon when it became parent the first was not comtely effective, Grooms said.

He said the regular chlorine dose parently failed to kill the larvae. Some residents had complained worms were clogging screens in ater taps. Others showed reorters glasses of water with worms

Grooms said such problems occur casionally during the fall, when lost standing water outdoors has ried up and mosquitoes and other sects are seeking places to lay
