Battle over, Dallas says it's bigger

United Press International DALLAS — In this state, where the boast of "everything's bigger in Texas" is still a matter of pride among some, a verbal war has raged over the size of two of the larger cities, Dallas and San Antonio. Well, now it's official — Dallas is bigger. Dallas' Chamber of Commerce has verified the city it represents is the seventh largest city in the United States — with a population of 884,850 — up from the 850,000 estimate earlier this year before the town of Kleberg voted to consolidate. San Antonio is tied, according to chamber figures, with Baltimore for eighth with 814,000 people. New York still tops the list with 7.4 million and Houston remains the largest city in Texas with a population of 1.6 million. Dallas' lower figure was estimated earlier this year by the City of Dallas and the North Texas Council of Governments. The 1970 census listed Dallas with a population of 844,000. The chamber of commerce made its announcement in connection with the release of a new promotional brochure for the city entitled, "Dallas, The City."

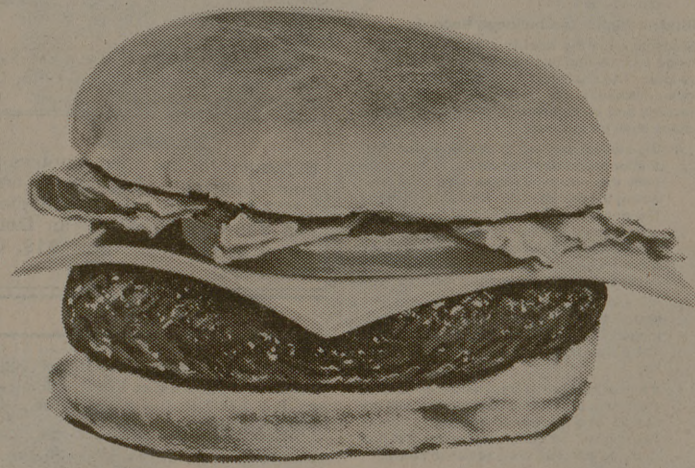

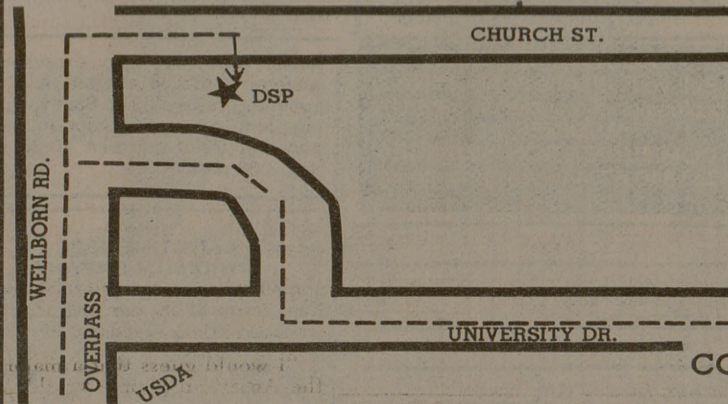
