'Godfather' of bridges plan to link Italy, Sicily The

ROME — Evoking a dream that began with the unification of Italy in 1862 but has roots in Homer, a state-backed consortium wants to build the world's longest suspension bridge between Italy and Sicily.

The bridge across the Strait of Messina, a notoriously rough and turbulent stretch of water, would have a central span twice as long as San Francisco's Golden Gate bridge and New York's Verrazano Narrows bridge put together. It would extend more than two miles.

Its two massive suspension pylons, one on the Italian mainland and the other on Sicily, would tower
