## Disabled find parking scant

Unauthorized parking in handicapped spaces may cause problems for more people than just those handicapped. People who continue in that practice could soon find their cars hauled away.

"I don't like to tow cars, but it's going to have to be done," said Tom Parsons, director of security and traffic for the Texas A&M University police.

The handicapped parking spaces are placed so that the handicapped student can have access to curb ramps and building ramps to go to classes.

"I don't like to tow cars, but it's going to have to be done," the traffic director of Texas A&M said.

"The handicapped spaces are all marked by a yellow 'X' and the word HANDICAPPED painted around the parking space," said Parsons.

"It's hard to get around if you can't park in the right place," said Roddy Dunnell, a sophomore from

Edinburg who is confined to a wheelchair. "Sometimes you have to go into the street, which can be real dangerous, because people without handicapped stickers park in the spaces. They force us to park where there are no ramps," Dunnell said.

"Sometimes you have to go into the street, which can be real dangerous, because people without handicapped stickers park in the spaces," one student confined to a wheelchair said.

"Some people park too close to the handicapped spaces and trap in or out of our cars."

"During the second summer session, I parked my van, and before I could get out a car blocked my way. I was trapped in my van for one hour, and it was sure hot," Dunnell said.

All the handicapped students that live on campus reside in the Commons area, said Ted Elliott, counselor for the Texas Rehabilitation Commission.

Overall, there are about 200 people with handicapped stickers, Elliott said.

## Spying and theft top FBI target list

CHICAGO — The FBI will begin extensive campaigns to thwart the top levels of white-collar criminals and to monitor spying by foreign governments, says Director William H. Webster.

Expressing confidence the agency is doing "exactly what the American people want," Webster said the FBI also will assign a volunteer cadre of special agents to root mob arson activity.

"The FBI is no longer interested in picking away at the lower echelons of white-collar crime," he said Tuesday at a Rotary Club luncheon. "We are now going to utilize undercover agents in this area."

Webster also said the FBI will increase the number of agents assigned to combat white-collar crimes such as corporate fraud, bank embezzlement and the corruption of elected officials.

Webster said new emphasis will be placed in stamping out computer

fraud and fraud involving magnetic audio and video tapes — a crime he said cost hundreds of thousands of dollars last year. He said efforts to monitor foreign spying also will be a priority in his tenure as FBI director, a post he took over in February of this year.

"Many people think the CIA has these responsibilities," Webster said. "But it is our job to dedicate a major part of our effort to these things, for example trying to neutralize hostile intelligence operations going on in this country."

Many who would not be admitted into their own countries if the situation were reversed, he said.

Webster also lauded Sen. Charles Percy, R-Ill., for his efforts to pass legislation authorizing the agency to investigate the increase of arms throughout the country.

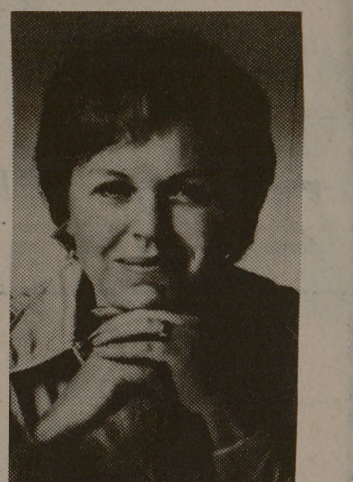
The FBI chief said the agency is equipped to handle an increase of terrorism and concentrate on developing new ways to combat crime with limited financial resources.
