Aggies host water polo tournament

The U.S. Olympic Committee is helping sponsor a water polo clinic this weekend at Texas A&M University.

Top people in the sport of water polo will be on hand to lecture, answer questions and give demonstrations.

"We are really lucky to get people

of this caliber to help with this clinic," said Dennis Fosdick, head swimming coach at Texas A&M.

Monte Nitzkowski will be on hand. He is the coach for the United States national team and past Olympic coach.

Tom Hermstad from California was the Olympic Games official in 1972 and 1976 and is the present World Games official.

Chris Dorst is a past NCAA All-American, 1976 NCAA Player of the Year and goalie for the 1978 U.S.

national team.

"Last year we had about 120 participants," Fosdick said. "This year we expect to go way above that."

Everyone is invited to participate. Registration begins at 8 p.m. today. Late registration will start at 8 a.m. Saturday.

The clinic will go through Sunday, with sessions beginning at 9 a.m. Sunday morning.

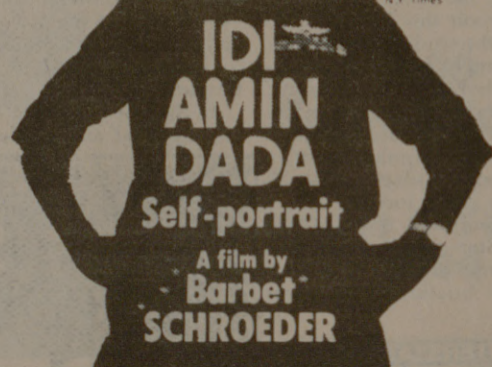

Davis sidelined

HOUSTON — The Oilers' Anthony Davis has broken a small bone in his lower left leg the second time in two months and he will be sidelined at least two weeks.

The injury, suffered in Sunday's game at Kansas City, was not diagnosed as a break until late Wednesday. X-rays showed the injury to be the same one Davis suffered on the first day of training camp in July.

In two regular season games Davis has carried the ball for four kickoff for a 24.5-yard average. He is considered by Oilers coaches as the team's fifth running back.

Oilers coach Bum Phillips has decided whether to place Davis on injured reserve status or keep him on the roster in hopes that he will recuperate quickly.
