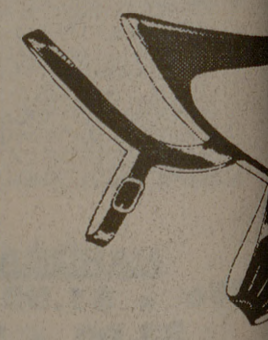

BEIRUT, Lebanon — The fighting in Beirut's turbulent, divided Lebanese capital cut the divided Lebanese capital from the rest of the world by filling hospitals with casualties and leaving the city without electricity.
Battles between Syrian and Christian militias raged all day and night despite an international arrangement for a cease-fire and a cease-fire intervention that could have been arranged if the Camp David accord had been implemented.
The United States urged Syria to exercise restraint and announced its backing for a plan to replace Syrian troops with a buffer force of Lebanese soldiers in the capital's dangerous areas and set up an international commission to oversee a cease-fire.
Diplomats at the United Nations said Secretary General Kurt Waldheim plans to send a special representative to Lebanon to try to end the fighting. He has authorized an evacuation of 176 U.N. staff and their 301 dependents from Beirut.

The Beirut fighting, confined to rocket duels, began when the Syrian forces and rightist militiamen began a ground battle for a strategic Christian shore batteries with Syrian naval vessels on the coast.
But it was the artillery and shelling — the Syrians heavier guns — that turned what was once the jewel of the East into a blackened, strewn city. Fires raged under black with the smoke of an burning out of control.
"Shelling continues up the moment and explosions among the northern and southern districts of the capital," Beirut Radio late Wednesday night.

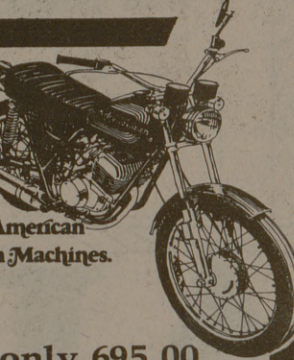
