Not all fast food bad, expert says

NEW ORLEANS - "Fast food" does not necessarily to junk food," a nutrition researcher reports.

Barbara Shannon, an associate professor of nutrition at Pe vania State University, recently told the American Dietetica tion that fast food chains often provide healthy, wholeso tion that fast food chains of the provide the source of a blanket endorsement. although she stopped well short of a blanket endorsement. Shannon said trends toward fast food and increased ea

among Americans pose serious questions for dieticians. "I think that nutrition educators have not traditionally

restaurant dining as one of the sources of food and nutrition have to realize that eating out is a way of life," she said in m

Eating at fast food restaurants - those with rapid, or ounter service — is approaching a volume of \$20 billion the United States.

Some people rely on fast food restaurants for as many as 10. week, Shannon's research has shown. And customers un of 35 choose a fast food place about 60 percent of the time w eat out.

There are three key questions about fast food eating as it h people's health, Shannon said: —How often do they eat out? —How nutritious is the food offered?

-What do they choose from among the offerings?

"This business of going around and saying all fast food is just is just not so," Shannon said. "There are many fast food items

Most sandwiches - hamburgers, cheeseburgers, "Big Ma filets and so forth - meet good nutrition requirements though some have too many calories. And, she points out, "if burger has tomato and lettuce on it, it's better from a nu standpoint than just a hamburger.

The least nutritional foods are easy to list.
