registrar.
Under the present Q-drop system students dropping courses only have a Q recorded in their permanent record, which has no effect on the

student's over-all grade point ratio.

Lacey said the Q-drop system goes into effect on the 12th class day and ends the fifth class day after mid-semester grades are reported. He said students have until 5 p.m.






