## Radioactive waste disposal **Report says burial can be**

WASHINGTON — The dangerous leftovers of nuclear fuel and weapons can be stored safely underground, a federal review group concluded today.

But it said such a program can be successful only if there is "much more attention to institutional issues" such as environmental con-cerns, a greater role for state and local officials, and a regional ap-

The report, which will be subjected to a month of public comment before becoming final, was made by the interagency review group set up by President Carter to look at nuclear waste disposal problems. We think the technical basis exists for reliance on disposal of






