# Carter stumps in Minnesota

MINNEAPOLIS, Minn. — Campaigning together for the first time since 1976, President Carter and Vice President Walter Mondale appealed to Minnesota voters Saturday to continue the Democratic Party's lock on the state's two Senate seats and the governorship.  
Carter opened the day's campaigning for Democrats in Wichita, Kan., where he signed a bill allowing China to buy U.S. farm products under American-guaranteed loan programs.  
Later, in Minneapolis, he signed a waterway toll bill levying upkeep taxes on commercial users of navigable rivers.  
Speaking in Rochester, Minn., famous for its Mayo Medical Clinic, Carter and Mondale both invoked the name of the late Sen. Hubert Humphrey while pleading with sharply divided Democratic-Farmer-Labor Party (DFL) members to re-elect Sen. Wendell Anderson and Gov. Rudy Perpich and

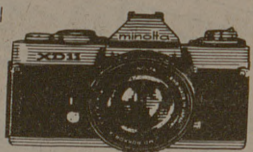
