FOR STUDENTS COMPLETING 92 HOURS AT THE END OF THE FALL '78 SEMESTER TO BE ELIGIBLE TO ORDER THE TEXAS A&M SENIOR CLASS RING, AN UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT MUST HAVE AT LEAST NINETY-TWO (92) SEMESTER HOURS, WITH 30 HOURS AT A&M AND BE IN GOOD STANDING. TO ORDER AT MID-SEMESTER USING MID-SEMESTER GRADES TO FULFILL THE ABOVE REQUIREMENTS, PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS:

1. LEAVE YOUR NAME, MAJOR AND I. D. NUMBER WITH THE RING CLERK, HEATON BUILDING, PRIOR TO NOVEMBER 1ST IF POSSIBLE, OR AT LEAST ONE WEEK IN ADVANCE OF ORDERING. THIS MAY NOT BE DONE BY PHONE.
2. BRING MID-SEMESTER GRADE REPORTS ALONG WHEN READY TO ORDER TO VERIFY PASSING HOURS.
3. ANYONE HAVING FAILED TO LEAVE THEIR NAME IN ADVANCE AND FAIL TO BRING THEIR MID-SEMESTER GRADE REPORT ALONG WHEN READY TO ORDER WILL BE ASKED TO RETURN LATER TO ALLOW TIME FOR RECORDS TO BE CHECKED.
4. ALL RINGS MUST BE PAID FOR IN FULL WHEN THE ORDER IS PLACED. SENIOR RING LOANS ARE AVAILABLE THROUGH STUDENT FINANCIAL AID IN THE YMCA BUILDING.
5. MID-SEMESTER ORDERS WILL BE TAKEN ONLY FROM OCTOBER 30TH UNTIL DECEMBER 1ST, 1978.
6. STUDENTS WHO DO NOT PLACE THEIR ORDER DURING THIS PERIOD MAY ORDER AFTER FINAL GRADES ARE POSTED. THERE WILL ONLY BE A 2-3 WEEK DIFFERENCE IN DELIVERY TIME FOR THOSE STUDENTS ORDERING IN JANUARY. (WHENEVER 92 HOURS HAVE BEEN COMPLETED AND ARE ON RECORD, THERE IS NEVER A DEAD-LINE, EXCEPT A MONTHLY MAILING DATE ON WHICH WE SEND ORDERS TO THE FACTORY).

**Times says Brezhnev's health failing**

United Press International LONDON — Soviet Press Leonid Brezhnev's health is so certain that Western observers believe he no longer can handle serious negotiations, the Times of London said Thursday.

The Times, in a front-page story by the newspaper's foreign editor Charles Douglas-Home, said Brezhnev's precarious health is the reason why the final stages of Strategic Arms Limitation talks are proving so difficult.

"The Americans," it said, "recognize that while the Soviet leader still able to stick closely to the brief is on the table in front of him, he is virtually unable to deviate from it or show any spontaneous flexibility."

The story said because of Brezhnev's limitations, any proposed summit meeting between him and President Carter will be little more than a formality, something left to chance.

The Times said Soviet Foreign Minister Andrei A. Gromyko had to shoulder the SALT talks alone and then has to go back to Brezhnev stage by stage.

"Brezhnev's health has been subject of speculation for some time, but his performance in the West that, while he is capable of paying visits and concluding business with other heads of state, he is no longer able to think in terms of diplomatic dealings," the Times story said.

In Bonn, Brezhnev, 71, had pulled up out of a chair and held up a small flight of stairs by aides.

The Times said the cause of Brezhnev's physical condition was not clear, although Western observers are confident it is not cancer.

**Gas blast blamed on weak pipe**

United Press International HOUSTON — Initial investigation of a natural gas pipeline that ruptured and exploded — killing three people — indicates "metal failure" rather than maintenance or operation problems was responsible for the blast.

Philip A. Hogue of the National Transportation Safety Board Wednesday said the remnants of the 12-inch pipeline had been taken to United Texas Transmission facility Deer Park, where efforts were under way to clean it sufficiently for close inspection.

"We have no evidence of operating failure or maintenance failure. We have no evidence of corrosion," Hogue said. "The pipe failed opening in the area of 550 to 575 psi per square inch and it had minimum yield strength of more than double that."

"We can't yet rule out a failure of a weld but it now appears more likely a metal failure of whatever type (other than corrosion) caused the rupture."

More than 40 people also were injured in the Tuesday morning blast.

Hogue said the NTSB would look at the company's response to recent complaints, the regulation of their operation and their emergency training.
