Auto operating costs soar

DETROIT — The cost of owning and operating a typical new car in 1978 surged upward more than 10 percent to an average of 33.1 cents per mile or \$3,310 a year, a study by the Hertz Corp. shows.

The annual survey released Sunday by the car rental and leasing firm was based on a normally equipped, intermediate-size two-door sedan driven 10,000 miles a year and kept for three years.

Comparable 1977 costs amounted to 30.1 cents a mile or \$3,010 a year, a 7 percent increase over the pre-

ceding year, Hertz said.
