## 'Traffic marker' bans smoking

NEW ORLEANS — Past the battery of sale posters and special sale notices near the department store doors, another sign with the authoritative appearance of a traffic marker informs shoppers about a

Against a white background, a cigarette has a broad red slash across it and an equally attention-commanding red circle around it. That part of the sign states explicitly, "No smoking." Underneath is a polite "Thank you. Retail Merchants Bureau.

That sign is common on store walls in New Orleans since the Retail Merchants Bureau instituted a uniform no-smoking policy in August. "The thing we've been amazed by was the voluntary compliance,"

said Vern Ewing, the bureau executive director Ewing said New Orleans is the only area he knows of with an no-smoking policy implemented by store owners rather than by law. Actually, state law prohibits smoking in sales areas, but

The merchants' motive for this policy was to reduce the threat of fire, but also to cut down on losses due to cigarette burns on merchandise and carpet. "While (each occurrence) is small, cumulatively it adds up. At the price of merchandise today...some stores might cut losses by \$10,000 to \$15,000 in a year, or more when you figure the prices of carpeting and unsightly appearance.

"The fact that people are more accustomed to smoking regulations and the fact that we approached it on a non-law standpoint (probably helped with customer compliance)," Ewing said.

He said store managers report good results although no statistics

"It's too early to tell on merchandise losses," Ewing said. "We have to evaluate it at the end of the year. A lot of the stores do 25 to 40 percent of their business in November and December, so I think that will be the point from a sample survey that tells whether it's helped
