ton negotiations were making un- Middle East peace settlement. precedented progress, but he re-fused to say whether this meant that all problems facing the negotiations have been resolved.



Davis attorneys seek bail in trial

AUSTIN - Attorneys for T. Cullen Davis Tuesday com prosecutors were acting in bad faith and violating the constitution rights of the Fort Worth millionaire to prevent his release on bal "There's no question that you're entitled to bail during trial," a torney Phil Burleson of Dallas told the Texas Court of Criminal A

Davis, arrested Aug. 20 on charges of soliciting the murder of Fort Worth judge who presided over Davis' bitter divorce battles, i on trial in Houston Prosecutors told the appeals court they did not appeal a For

Worth judge's order denying bail on Sept. 1 and cannot deman release while the trial is in progress.

At issue is the legal interpretation of a provision in the Texas Constitution allowing a judge to refuse bail to a defendant charged with felony offense while he is free on bail for previous felony indictments. Davis last year in a sensational Amarillo trial was acquitted charges he shot and killed his 12-year-old stepdaughter in a midni ambush after learning his divorce trial had been delayed. He mained free under a \$350,000 bond for other charges stemming for the Aug. 2, 1976, shooting spree that wounded his wife, Priscilla a killed her lover, Stan Farr, at the \$4 million Davis mansion in Fo

Houston attorney Randy Schaffer argued prosecutors should not be permitted to use the unresolved charges to deny Davis bail on the new allegation that he conspired to have District Judge Joe H. Eidsn of Fort Worth killed.
