Tradition 'shot down'

Rifle range facility closed

Last Friday another one of Texas A&M University's traditions was shot down, according to marksmanship instructor Capt. Doug Veitch.

The rifle range facility under the stands at Kyle Field was closed because of the stadium expansion.

"Freshmen in the Corps have

been qualifying for marksmanship at Kyle Field since before the war," Veitch said. "Even the Commandant (Col. James R. Woodall) qualified here when he was a freshman."

"These are the last of the Mohicans," Veitch said of the 60-odd cadets who completed seven weeks of marksmanship instruction and training Friday. Veitch said he did not know

when or where a new range facility would be built.

The cadets are tested in marksmanship in the prone, kneeling, and standing positions. They use a Remington 410 rifle, the standard target rifle.

The last cadet to qualify at Kyle Field range was Cadet T. Beatty, a freshman animal science major.

Hill files gas suit for three states

OKLAHOMA CITY — Texas Attorney General John Hill filed a joint petition for Texas, Oklahoma and Louisiana Monday, asking a federal court to strike down the Na-

tional Gas Policy Act of 1978 as unconstitutional.

The lawsuit against the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission contends Washington has no authority to regulate intrastate fuel prices nor limit what the three states can charge for gas produced on state-owned lands.

Hill's petition complains enforcement of the act will disrupt the economies and tax structures of all three states and "deprive the states of millions of dollars in revenues that would accrue to them under free-market prices exceeding federal ceilings."

Louisiana, Oklahoma and Texas finance a major portion of their public education programs with revenues from taxes and royalties on natural gas production.

The lawsuit also complains the federal legislation will force the

Oklahoma Corporation Commission, Texas Railroad Commission and Louisiana Department of Natural Resources to spend a substantial amount of money and additional staff to help the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission implement the legislation.

Hill asked the U.S. District Court for the Western District of Oklahoma to declare the statute unconstitutional, forbid Congress to raise prices of natural gas produced on state-owned lands and prohibit Washington from implementing mandatory allocation of natural gas within the three states.

Primary target of the bill is the extension for the first time of federal price controls to natural gas, but the three states are protesting the emergency regulation of gas to interstate supply the Northeast.

FOR STUDENTS COMPLETING 92 HOURS AT THE END OF THE FALL '78 SEMESTER TO BE ELIGIBLE TO ORDER THE TEXAS A&M SENIOR CLASS RING, AN UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT MUST HAVE AT LEAST NINETY-TWO (92) SEMESTER HOURS, WITH 30 HOURS AT A&M AND BE IN GOOD STANDING. TO ORDER AT MID-SEMESTER USING MID-SEMESTER GRADES TO FULFILL THE ABOVE REQUIREMENTS, PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS:

1. LEAVE YOUR NAME, MAJOR AND I. D. NUMBER WITH THE RING CLERK, HEATON BUILDING, PRIOR TO NOVEMBER 1ST IF POSSIBLE, OR AT LEAST ONE WEEK IN ADVANCE OF ORDERING. THIS MAY NOT BE DONE BY PHONE.
2. BRING MID-SEMESTER GRADE REPORTS ALONG WHEN READY TO ORDER TO VERIFY PASSING HOURS.
3. ANYONE HAVING FAILED TO LEAVE THEIR NAME IN ADVANCE AND FAIL TO BRING THEIR MID-SEMESTER GRADE REPORTS TO ORDER WILL BE ASKED TO RETURN LATER TO ALLOW TIME FOR RECORDS TO BE CHECKED.
4. ALL RINGS MUST BE PAID FOR IN FULL WHEN THE ORDER IS PLACED. SENIOR RING LOANS ARE AVAILABLE THROUGH STUDENT FINANCIAL AID IN THE YMCA BUILDING.
5. MID-SEMESTER ORDERS WILL BE TAKEN ONLY FROM OCTOBER 30TH UNTIL DECEMBER 1ST, 1978.
