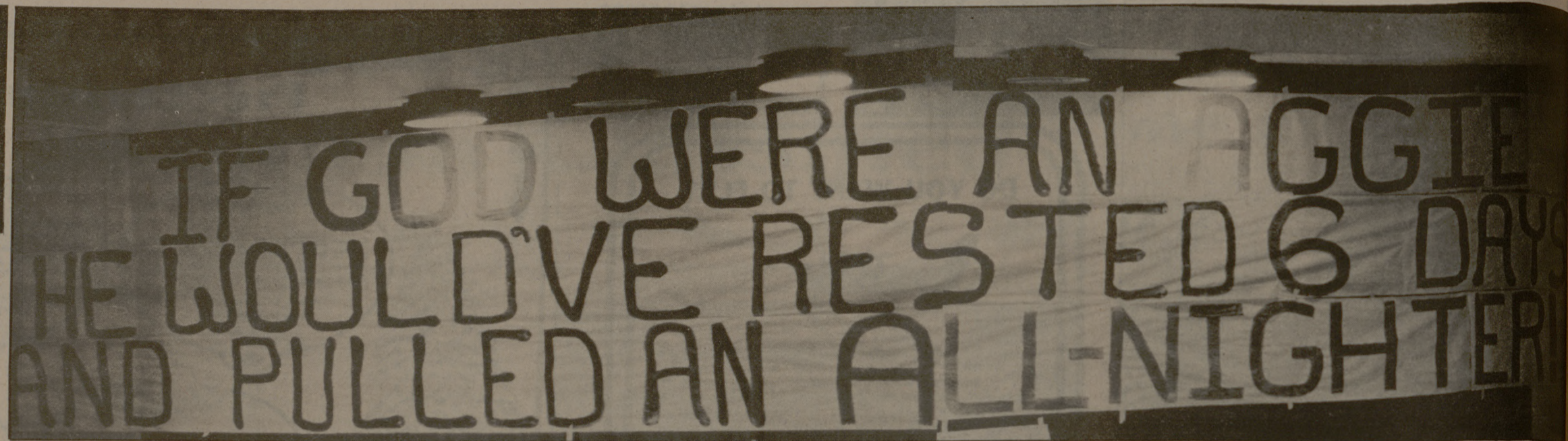

Gallup favors Carter more than A&M poll

Texas A&M University student opinion of how President Carter is handling his job is lower than that of

the rest of the country, according to a survey taken by three marketing students.

The three students, Robert Mueller, Bobby Merrifield and James

Trott, based their survey on a Gallup Poll taken in September. The Gallup Poll represents a cross section of opinion in the United States. One hundred fifty-eight Texas

A&M students took part in the survey. Of those surveyed, 102 were males. Ten of the students were members of the Corps of Cadets, 42 were on-campus, and the rest were off-campus students.

The poll takers tried to get a representative proportion of each student group in the survey. The results of the survey were compared with the results of the

Gallup Poll. The students answered questions approve, disapprove or no opinion. On the question of how Carter is handling his job as president, 63 percent of those surveyed disapproved. Forty-four percent disapproved in the Gallup Poll. All 10 of the cadets surveyed disapproved.

Only 17 percent of the students polled approved of the way Carter is handling domestic policy, compared

to a 32 percent approval nationwide. The greatest disagreement with Carter's policy is with his handling of the inflation problem. Seventy-nine percent of the students polled said they disapproved. Sixty-two percent responded in the Gallup Poll disapproved.

Students also strongly disapproved of Carter's handling of the inflation problem. Seventy-eight percent disapproved on the Texas A&M campus. Gallup Poll showed 66 percent approved.

The Gallup Poll and the survey were close on the question of how Carter is dealing with employment. Forty-eight percent of the students disapproved and 48 percent in the Gallup Poll.

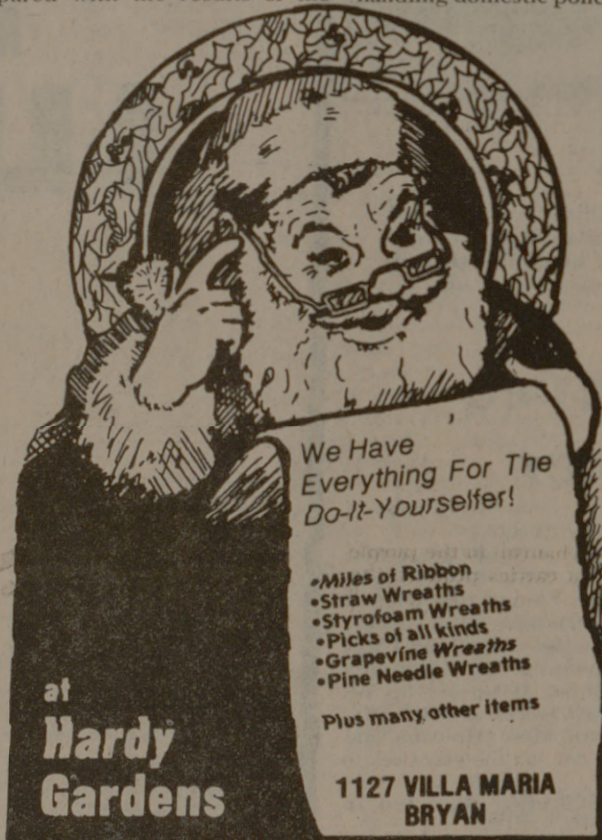
On the question of how Carter is handling environmental problems, the largest plurality opinion at A&M was no opinion at 37 percent. Largest Gallup group showed 37 percent approved.

The students surveyed disapproved of Carter's energy policy 57 percent. Forty-two percent approved in the Gallup Poll.

Carter did best in his handling of the Middle East situation. Sixty-three percent of the students surveyed approved.

The Gallup Poll was taken at the Camp David summit between Menachem Begin of Israel and Anwar Sadat of Egypt. A poll was taken later and showed 63 percent approval of Carter's Middle East policy after Camp David.

Both the Gallup Poll and the student survey showed similar results on how Carter deals with the Soviet Union. The students were 43 percent against, while the Gallup showed 43 percent against.
