## Key Temple aide seeks immunity

United Press International - Federal agents investigating the assassination of Rep. Leo Ryan, D-Calif., met Wednesday with attorney Mark Lane and Terri Buford, one of the Rev. Jim Jones' key aides in the People's Temple, UPI has learned.

The meeting was held in a San Jose, Calif., hotel under tight security and was attended by FBI agents and representatives of the Justice Department.

Lane was seeking immunity from prosecution for Buford, 24, who was to be a principal assistant to Buford was reported to be turned to San Francisco, Guyana in September to take over the temple. She has been described by former cult members as the person who kept important records including a so-called "list of enemies."

A federal source said it is not decided whether the immunity sought by Lane for her share of the information to give her immunity. A federal grand jury in San Francisco is scheduled to begin its work on Wednesday. Ryan, who was killed in the San Francisco area, was on a jungle airstrip in Guyana. Among those subpoenaed were persons who flew from Guyana New York Wednesday.

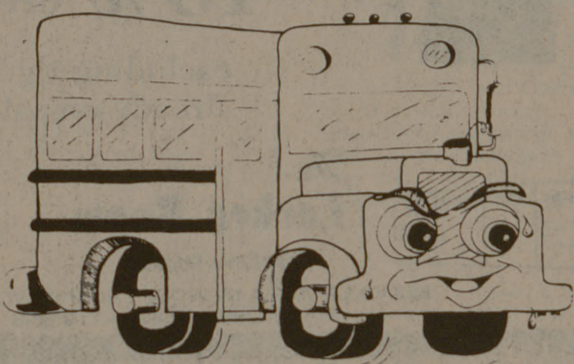
