### A&M scholarship recipients named by rodeo six club

Six Texas A&M University students have been named recipients of Texas Aggie Rodeo Scholarships. Awarded \$300 each were: Bobby Cobb and Glenda Chapman, Haskell; Joe Dutton, Junction; Beverly Acton, Cuero; Clayton Zwerschke, Bryan; and Dawn Higgins, Dallas. Part of the scholarship money comes from over \$2,500 awarded to the association from the Copenhagen-Skoal Scholarship Awards Program. This is the largest group of students ever to receive rodeo scholarships at Texas A&M, said Corkey Sandel, Texas Aggie Rodeo Association sponsor. Recipients are chosen on the basis of financial need, club participation, academics and how well they have performed in rodeo events, Sandel noted. The next competition will be held Feb. 22-24 at the Southwest Texas State University Rodeo in San Marcos.

### A&M professor wins agronomy award

The American Society of Agronomy has presented one of its major awards, the Agronomic Resident Education Award, to Dr. Murray Milford, professor of soil science at Texas A&M University. Milford was honored at the society's annual banquet Dec. 6 in Chicago. The award recognizes educational innovations developed and used successfully in the university classroom. Milford's responsibilities include teaching introductory soil science and undergraduate seminars, serving as departmental graduate student adviser and coordinating assistantship support for graduate students. He has served on Texas A&M's Academic Council and on

several university and college committees and is presently a member of the dean's faculty advisory committee in the College of Agriculture.

### Six math students capture cash awards

Six Texas A&M University students have won cash in the undergraduate mathematics contest campus. Alan V. Noell of Dallas was the top \$100 honor as first-class winner. Second-class winner was C. Taylor of College Station. Third-class category winners were Ferguson and Tom George, Longview; Mark Stern of Dallas; Steven Wadding of Seabrook. They were furnished by the Association of Former Students. Competition involved solving a number of math problems.

### Environmental design and vet medicine students team up for awards

Environmental design and veterinary medicine students at A&M University have joined to win a veterinary clinic design contest. The eight students were members of a competition sponsored by Hill's Division, Rivianna Foods, Topeka, Kan. Students were asked to design a clinic for two veterinarians to be located inside a new shopping mall. The winners were Sterling Thompson, Waco and Edwards, Bryan, first place; Bill Cisneros, San Antonio, and Bill Loway, College Station, second place; Amaya, San Antonio, and Richard Henderson, and Bert Dodd, Laco, fourth place. The winners received \$1,000 in prize money.

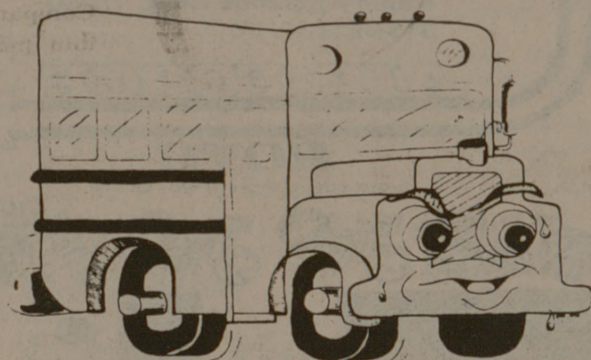

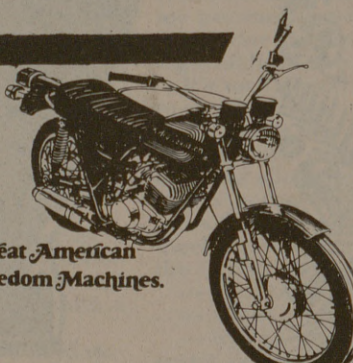
