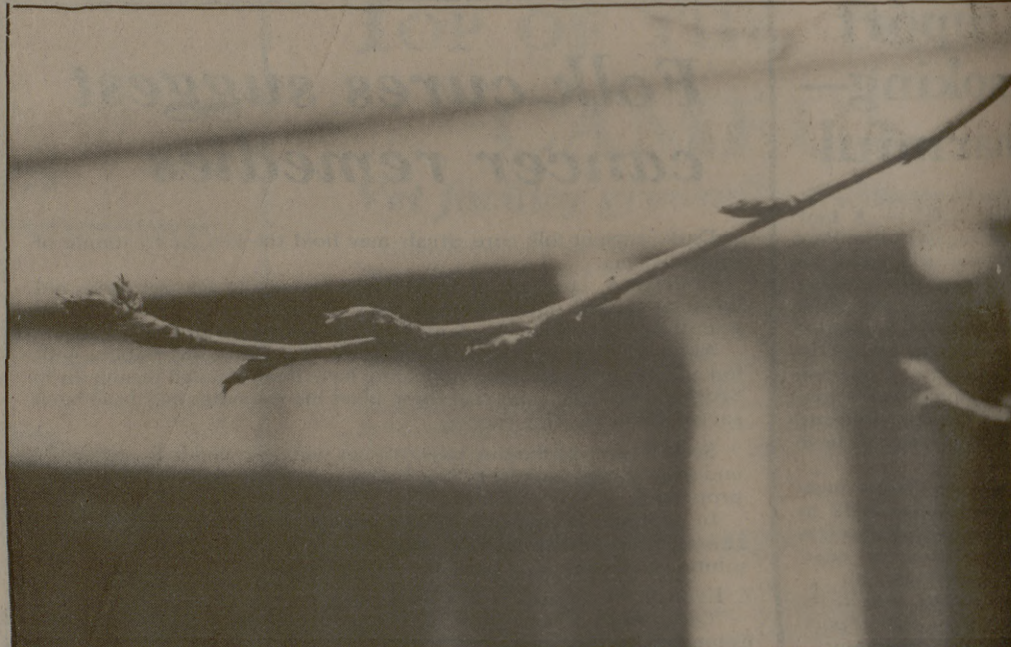

## Simplicity best policy, sleuth advises crooks

**MILWAUKEE** — He looks a bit more like Dr. Watson than Sherlock Holmes, but many say Dr. Keith Simpson is the modern counterpart of the legendary hero of Baker Street.

On a cold snowy day on Water Street — at the Sherlock Holmes Pub — Simpson, 71, had rapt attention as he told of his 40 years of crime detection as pathologist for Scotland Yard.

The stories he told were of crimes he solved with the barest of details. He said he felt he was similar to Holmes and "his remarkable eye for minutiae."

Details as small as human gallstones, which Simpson used to trip up a murderer who thought he

had committed the perfect crime.

In the "Case of the Four Gallstones," a wealthy widow was killed and robbed and her body dumped into a steel drum of sulphuric acid. The murderer thought he had committed the perfect crime, having disposed of the body.

Simpson, despite the murderer's care, found four human gallstones that did not dissolve in the acid. From that evidence, the murder was reconstructed and the assailant eventually was hanged.

Another of Simpson's cases had a similar telling detail. The "Case of the Yellow Lettuce" involved a man who had hacked his wife to death, buried the body and then, weeks later, set fire to the house.

One of the firemen, a gardener, saw high weeds growing, somewhat unusual area. So the ground was dug and a half feet below was good fertilizer. Simpson said that delighted him. Simpson, the escaped convict, his search for the "small use of medical tools" in crimes, "opened a new detection."

## Cambodia seeks U.S. support against Vietnam

**TOKYO** — Cambodia's Norodom Sihanouk said Tuesday he wants to meet with Secretary of State Cyrus Vance in Washington to seek U.S. support for Cambodia's fight against Vietnam.

The portly former playboy flew into Tokyo's international airport at Narita from Peking to New York.

He had been expected to attend an emergency meeting of the Nations security council, but a news conference he was to give at the meeting would take the cause of opposition by the United and Czechoslovakia.

The Cambodian campaign of Premier Pol Pot Sihanouk from nearly four years ago house arrest last weekend to him China.

Sihanouk, dressed in a suit, said, "I will go to Washington to try to see Secretary Vance in order to press on the U.S. government."

He said U.S. support of the form of helping Cambodia have a discussion inside the council about the Vietnam as well as leading diplomatic activities in the area to put some pressure on the Vietnamese and Cambodians then put an end to international Cambodia.

Sihanouk said the Vietnamese surged forces seized all towns in Cambodia in a attack.

The two towns that he still in the hands of the Khmer Rouge are Battambang and Siem Reap near Cambodia's Angkor Wat ruins.

He said that if he is able to make an appeal at the United Nations would emphasize that Cambodia "is not a child of the rebel United Front government, but created by Vietnam."
