Women follow Leg Abzug and qu

WASHINGTON — More than half of President Carter's women's advisory committee resigned Saturday to protest the president's firing of co-chairwoman Bella Abzug, charging that Carter thinks "women should be seen but not heard."

Ms. Abzug called her abrupt dismissal "quite cruel" and "totally shocking" and said, "I can't believe he thought this through."

The outspoken committee leader was summoned to presidential aide Hamilton Jordan's office Friday after the 40-member National Advisory Committee for Women had just met for the first time with Carter. She was praising the session with Carter when Jordan asked her to resign.

Ms. Abzug was joined at Saturday's hastily called news conference by a dozen of the 20 committee members who quit "in solidarity" with her.

A committee official said she believed another eight members would resign, which would raise the protest defections to 28 of the 40 members.

The White House had no immediate comment on the mass resignations.

"We are deeply shocked at the president's unwarranted dismissal of our co-chair, Bella Abzug, who has acted at the direction and interests of the full committee," the resigning members said in a statement on the letterhead of the committee.

"We regret the necessary resignation, but we see no alternative. We believe that all women of like mind will refuse to join in an advisory committee that has been formed in disagreement with the and legitimate criticisms acceptable."

Carter appointed the committee months ago to continue the 1977 government National Women's Conference in Houston.

It came quickly into Carter, canceling its first meeting with him last week because he had group only 15 minutes.
