# DeBakey quits transplants

LAS VEGAS, Nev. - Dr. Michael DeBakey, a cardiovascular expert who performed some of the world's first heart transplants, said Monday he was performing no heart transplant surgery and did not expect to in the future because of the low success rate.

The Houston cardiovascular specialist said he performed a total of 12 heart transplants and two of the patients survived. He has done no transplants for two years.

DeBakey did not rule out the possibility of remarkable new advances in transplant technique but said he was not involved in the research. He said the advent of bypass surgery lessened the importance of heart transplants.

"Bah, you can also have a heart

attack while driving a car," said Johnson. "It is largely a matter of proper preparation and a gradual increase in the time and distance involved."

BANGKOK, Thailand — A Vietnamese-led column preceded by Cambodian rebel scouts, Monday slowly closed in on the town of Poipet near the Cambodia-Thailand border, tightening the invaders' already solid grip on Cam-

But officials at the Thai border said they believed the Vietnamese were delaying the capture of Poipet — the final target in their 22-day blitzkreig — to allow reporters to witness Cambodian rebels, rather than Vietnamese, capturing the

Despite intelligence reports to the contrary, Vietnam has persis-tently claimed the invasion is the work of the Hanoi-backed Cambodian "Salvation Front," not a Vietnamese offensive

PEKING — About 100 peasants demanding more food and rights marched through Peking's main thoroughfare and toward Premier Hua Kuofeng's residence near the Forbidden City.

Old, ragged-clothed country folks chanted "Down With Oppression" or "We Are Hungry" in a peaceful demonstration Sunday.

They tried to see Hua but guards at his house turned them away. The demonstration — the second within a week — drew hundreds of
