

Mexicans green Pope warmly

OAXACA, Mexico — Pope John Paul II Monday flew to Ma southern jungles where thousands of Indians welcomed him, s traditional garb and doing ancient dances.

The pope was wearing his white robes and skullcap, but car wide-brimmed straw cowboy hat, as he emerged from his helio

A cross was drawn in lime beside a 16th century Dominion vent to mark a landing spot for the pontiff's helicopter south of aca, from where John Paul continued on to the village of Color about 9 miles south of the city.

Thousands of persons had gathered there before dawn, them Indians of the Mixtee and Zapotee tribes, whose ances centuries ago built the nearby city of Monte Alban, the stoner which are a major tourist attraction.

"El papa, el papa," chanted the crowd at the landing site "It pleases me much to hear the words of the indiger guages," the pope said in a speech at the landing site.
"The pope and the church are with you — you, your cult

The crowd broke into cheers when he expressed "solida your cause — the cause of the humble people, the poor."

It was a sharp contrast from an incident Sunday, before acr 200,000 city dwellers and church leaders in Puebla, when Jo made a passing reference to "the simple joys of the poor," hiss from some members of the group.
