# Informal hearing held for cult worshipers

WASHINGTON — Rep. Hamilton Fish, R-N.Y., knows firsthand the anguish some parents feel when

their children join religious cults. His 25-year-old daughter, Alexis, is a member of Sun Myung Moon's Unification Church.

church leaders last week sent Dole a letter accepting his desire to hold educational hearings for members interested in the cult phenomenon, but complaining that "all of the witnesses you have scheduled appear to have definite positions in support of regulations of 'cult' activity."

Monday's informal hearing was criticized by religious leaders. Scheduled witnesses included "deprogrammer" Ted Patrick, and Jackie Speier, legislative assistant to the late Rep. Leo Ryan, D-Calif. Ryan was murdered by Peoples Temple cult members in Jonestown, Guyana, just before the ritual murder-suicide that killed more than 900 people.

...Not one of us cares to defend all of the tactics or theologies of every religious group in America, but we are very clear that the legitimate free exercise of religion must never be abridged," the letter said.

Unification church members have obtained a permit allowing 200 persons to demonstrate outside the Senate office building where the hearings were set.

Dole then invited the National Council of Churches and the American Civil Liberties Union to send witnesses.
