Flight ban on cigar, pipe smoke

HOUSTON — Saying it is eliminating the "most noxious nicotine sources," Texas International Airlines Wednesday is forcing passengers to choose between its low fares and lighter cigars or pipes.

The airline announced its ban cigar and pipe smoking on its domestic and international flights, effective today.

The announcement was Tuesday by TIA President Lorenzo, himself a cigar smoker who said:

"Cigar and pipe smokers will choose between Texas International's low fares and their smoking preferences. Lorenzo said the decision was made because of increasing passenger complaints about cigars and pipes. He added that regulations now require all U.S. airlines to segregate cigar and pipe smokers within the present section to provide protection for non-smokers.

"Our cabin crews who are fined to the aircraft, many of them are women who smoke cigars or pipes, are forced to wear atmospheric smoke most of the hours of the day," Lorenzo said. "This ban eliminating the noxious of those fumes benefits our personnel as well as our passengers."
