DALLAS — Southern Methodist athletic director Russ Potts said Monday he had recommended to school president Dr. James Zumberge that basketball coach Sonny Allen be retained for at least another

Allen had been under some pressure because of his team's failure to challenge for the Southwest Conference's first division this season. The Mustangs ended their season last Saturday with a loss to Houston in the opening round of the league's post-season tournament, finishing 11-16.

"I met with Coach Allen and his staff Saturday night," Potts said. 'And the meeting was a very productive one. In that meeting I spelled out several objectives that must be met next basketball season.

"I will not elaborate on certain specifics, but overall the goal is that SMU will be competitive for the SWC championship next year.

Potts said Allen had been given an expanded budget for recruiting and would be able to add another
