SENIOR RING ORDERING PROCEDURE FOR STUDENTS COMPLETING 92 HOURS AT THE END OF THE SPRING '79 SEMESTER

To be eligible to order the Texas A&M Senior Ring, an undergraduate student must have at least ninety-two (92) semester hours, with 30 hours at A&M and be in good standing with the university. To order at mid-semester using mid-semester grades to fulfill the above requirements, please note the following instructions:

1. Mid-semester orders will be taken only from March 20th until April 27, 1979.
2. Leave your name, major and I.D. number with the ring clerk, Heaton Building, prior to March 20th if possible, or at least one week in advance of ordering. This may not be done by phone.
3. Bring mid-semester grade reports along when ready to order to verify passing hours for the spring semester only.
4. Anyone having failed to leave their name in advance and fail to bring their mid-semester grade report along when ready to order will be asked to return later to allow time for records to be checked.
5. All rings must be paid for in full when the order is placed. Senior ring loans are available through Student Financial Aid in the YMCA building.
6. Students who do not place their order during this period may order after final grades are posted. There will be only a 1-2 week difference in delivery time for those students ordering after final grades are posted during May. (Whenever 92 hours have been completed and are on record, there is never a dead-line, except a monthly mailing date on which we send orders to the factory.)
7. The ring clerk is on duty from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., each day, Monday through Friday. However in order for other duties to be carried out, no orders will be taken between 11:30 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. or between 4:00 - 5:00 p.m.
8. All rings ordered, regardless of whether on March 20th or April 27th, will be delivered on the same day which will be approximately July 18, 1979.

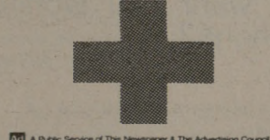

A&M research marks No. 2,000

The Texas A&M University Research Foundation has marked its 2,000th project.
Informal ceremonies last week recognized Dr. Joseph Osaba, Petroleum Engineering Department with the 2,000th project.
Osaba is principle investigator for a study entitled "Enhancement of Oil from Subsurface Reservoirs with Carbon Dioxide." Remarks by Fred J. Benson, vice president for engineering, lighted the observance. A longtime member of the foundation, Benson commended the organization for its work incorporated in 1944 as a non-profit entity to serve Texas in the research foundation develops and administrators sponsored research to help the university attain excellence in education.
Texas A&M's volume of research has grown dramatically over years, totaling \$60.1 million for fiscal year 1977-78, up \$8.3 million from the previous year.

Alcoholic is 'satisfactory' after mouthwash overdose

KISSIMEE, Fla. — An alcoholic who tried to ease the transition from drinking to doing without by swallowing 10 bottles of mouthwash was reported resting in satisfactory condition Monday.

Police said they were summoned Sunday by a convenience store clerk who became alarmed at the amount of mouthwash a 45-year-old Kissimee man was buying. The brand he purchased contains 35 percent alcohol, according to paramedics. They said Center for Disease Control officials in Atlanta said the mouthwash had the same amount of aspirin when used in small amounts.

The man told police he had a drink in eight weeks started again last week while a dog track, then developed lirim tremors when he stopped.
He hoped the mouthwash would quell his shakes.
A spokeswoman for the Medical Center, where he was hospitalized, refused to discuss his treatment.
