**SENIOR RING ORDERING PROCEDURE FOR STUDENTS COMPLETING 29 SEMESTER OF THE SPRING '79 SEMESTER**

To be eligible to order the Texas A&M Senior Ring, an undergraduate student must have at least ninety-two (92) semester hours, with 30 hours at A&M and be in good standing with the university. To place your name, major and I.D. number with the ring clerk, Heaton Building, prior to March 20th if possible, or at least one week in advance of ordering. This may not be done by phone.

2. Leave your name, major and I.D. number with the ring clerk, Heaton Building, prior to March 20th if possible, or at least one week in advance of ordering. This may not be done by phone.

3. Bring mid-semester grades to order to verify passing hours for the spring semester.

4. Anyone having failed to leave their name in advance and fail to bring their mid-semester grade report along when ready to order will be asked to place their name in advance.

5. Student who do not place their order during this period may order after final grades are posted. There will be only a 1-2 week difference in delivery time for those students ordering after final grades are posted during May (Whenever 92 hours have been completed and are on record, the ring order is on daily from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. each day, Monday through Friday. However in order for other orders to be carried out, no orders will be delivered on March 20th or 21st, or between 4:00 - 5:00 p.m.

6. All rings ordered, regardless of whether on March 20th or April 27th, will be delivered on the same day which will be approximately July 15, 1979.
