#### March 29, Thursday

LOGAN'S RUN (1976) 118 min. Michael York, Peter Ustinov, and Jenny Agutter. Winner of Academy Award for best special effects. This film portrays life in the 23rd century where no one is allowed to live past 30. Logan (Michael York) is a member of the death squad who eliminate "runners" trying to escape ceremonial execution. When Logan faces "Lastday" he seeks refuge. (PG) 7 p.m.

BARBARELLA (1968) 98 min. In the year 40,000, Barbarella (Jane Fonda) is assigned to locate a missing scientist. She acts like a female James Bond, vanquishing evil. She also rewards, in an uninhibited manner, the handsome men who assist her. A cult favorite. (PG) 9:30 p.m.

#### March 30, Friday

**COLLISIONS** (1978) 90 min. Unrated. Starring Lily Tomlin with Gilda Radner and Dan Ackroyd of NBC's *Saturday Night Live*. Earth is on a collision course with the unseen planet, Zhymus, which sends a representative to Earth, Tomlin, in the disguise of a TV newscaster. Her job is to determine whether or not Earth is worth saving. Utilizing a combination of animation, song, and dance; this film is a sensitive story of the human condition from birth to death to op culture and politics. (PG) **7 p.m**.

**EXORCIST** (1975) 121 min. Linda Blair, Lee J. Cobb, Jason Miller. The Exorcist is based on a 1949 case in which a Jesuit priest expelled a demon from a 14 year old girl in Maryland. This film portrays the fear and anguish surrounding demonic possession while exploring the nature of evil. (R) 8:45 p.m.

ROLLERBALL (1975) 123 min. James Caan and John Houseman. This provocative film pictures society in the 21st century, a world entirely dominated by six megacorporations. The only outlet for aggressive behavior is "Rollerball", a vicious game broadcast to billions of viewers and designed to channel anti-social feelings that might interfere with economic growth. (R) 11 p.m. COUNTDOWN 101 min. James Caan, Robert Duvall and Joanna Moore. When NASA learns that the Russians are close to landing the first man on the moon, a crash program is instituted. American astronaut training is halted when a Russian spaceship is reported maneuvering for a lunar landing. U.S. experts decide to send an astronaut (James Caan) on a moon mission without delay. Ignoring orders, he lands and finds the Russian craft destroyed and crew dead. Caan plants the American Flag and waits to see if he will survive until Apollo arrives. 
