Thursday, April 5 is quite a night! No less than 5 sports will have their final matches on that night.

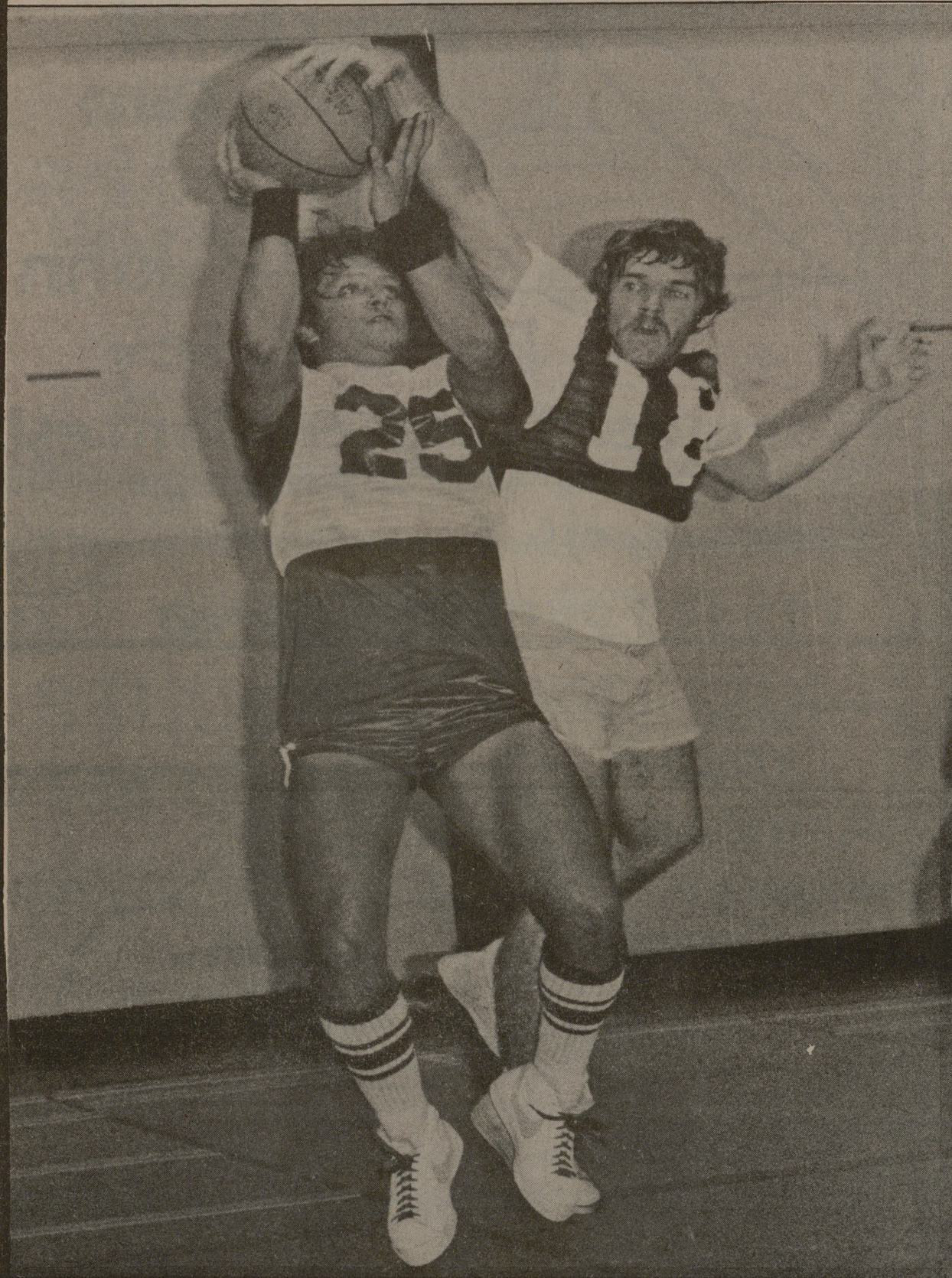

Laro Clark goes for "two" in a basketball playoff game between DDT and the Derelicts. DDT won 68-32.

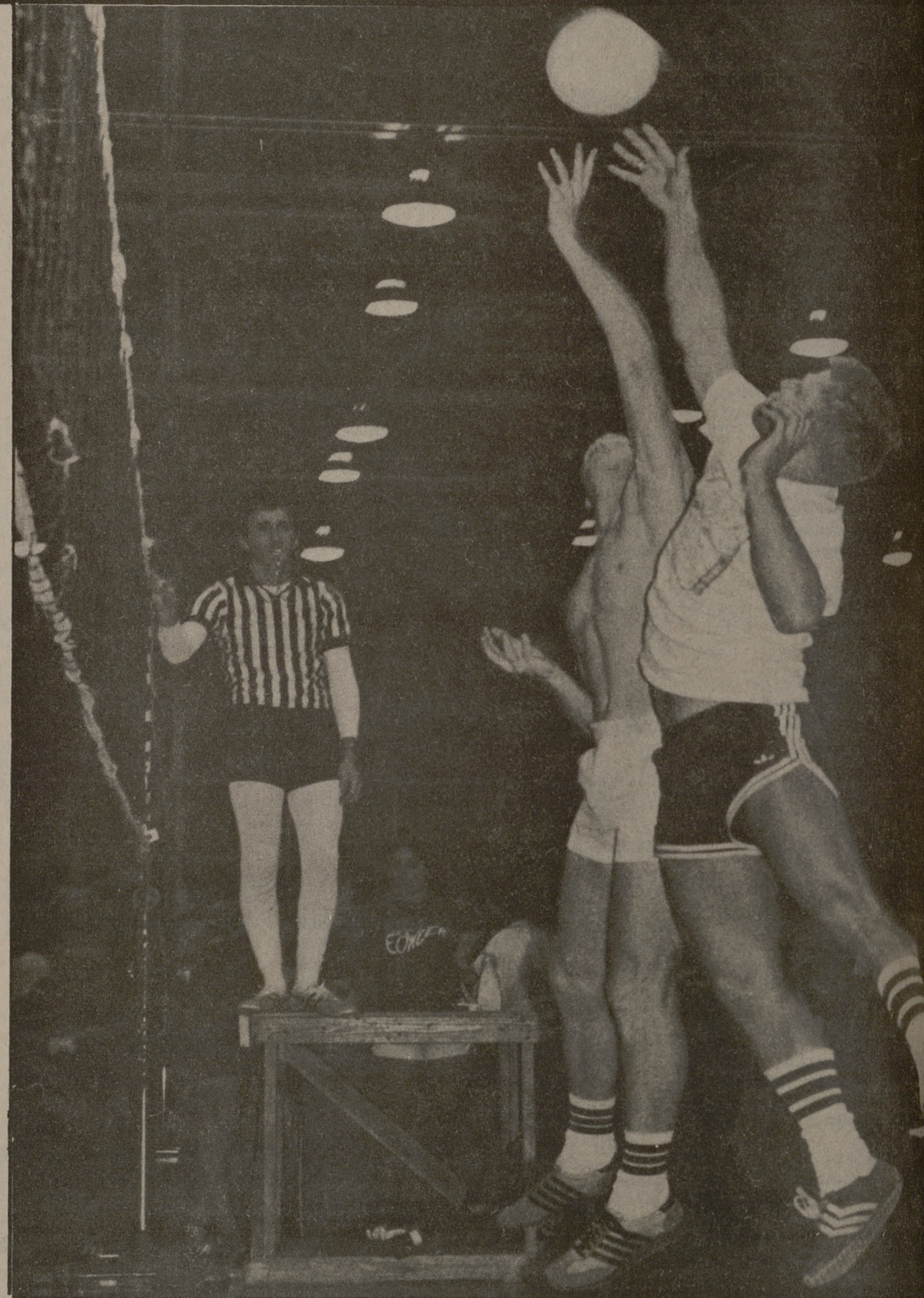
## Zip Day Results
