### 1942 graduate to speak on safari

Going on an African safari involve more than riding across the jeep, being dressed in khaki and chasing wild animals.  
Tom Gillis, a 1942 graduate of Texas A&M University, returned from a 28-day safari on Thursday at 7:30 p.m. in the car of the Memorial Student Center.  
Gillis, his wife Frankie, son and daughter Amy were in Kenya last fall, mainly to hunt for big five animals (elephant, cape buffalo, rhinoceros, lion and zebra), as well as other such animals like giraffes, baboons. They usually hunt for what they killed with the lion, which Gillis said is a taste.  
The family visited South Africa, Kenya, Sudan, and the Congo Empire. But driving was only one method of transportation. Gillis estimates he walked 280 miles.  
Another purpose for the safari was a camera expedition. In Kenya, slides of village natives and day African life will be shown Thursday night with Gillis in the center of the stage.  
Gillis is still in close contact with the Texas A&M Travel Bureau on a chartered plane to the Alps and was once the club's club adviser. "He was a tremendous help and assistance and gave know-how to put it all together," MSC director J. Wayne Stansel said.

### Silkwood's family testified in court case

OKLAHOMA CITY — Silkwood's concern for her co-workers at the plutonium plant was typical of her general attitude toward people at the plutonium plant, sister testified in federal court.  
Testifying before a packed gallery, Linda Silkwood of Nederland, said Karen "very caring and loving person." "I idolized her," she said.  
The family's attorney, Spence, asked the witness to describe a typical day of Karen to help people at the plutonium plant.  
"Yes," she replied.  
Miss Silkwood described Karen, who died in 1974.  
"She had a great love for and for people," Silkwood said.  
Her testimony came in the an \$11.5 million personal injury lawsuit her family has filed against the state.  
The suit contends that negligence was responsible for Karen Silkwood's contamination with cancer-causing plutonium.  
Testifying briefly before was her father, Bill, described life as a laborer and later as an employed painter.  
Spence asked him if it was "difficult to talk" about his daughter.  
"Yes, I do," Silkwood said softly.  
Silkwood told the court she asked many questions about her daughter's work.  
Earlier in the trial, a labor official testified Karen never was pressured to give evidence supporting her father's claim that she had falsified control reports on nuclear fuel rods.  
Oil, Chemical and Atomic Workers Union official Steve Waddell Monday he told Silkwood he wanted to bring a New York Times reporter to Oklahoma to help charges unless she had proof.

**SENIOR RING ORDERING PROCEDURE FOR STUDENTS COMPLETING 92 HOURS AT THE END OF THE SPRING '79 SEMESTER**

To be eligible to order the Texas A&M Senior Ring, an undergraduate student must have at least ninety-two (92) semester hours, with 30 hours at A&M and be in good standing with the university. To order at mid-semester using mid-semester grades to fill the above requirements, please note the following instructions:

- Mid-semester orders will be taken only from March 20th until April 27, 1979.
- Leave your name, major and I.D. number with the ring clerk, Heaton Building, prior to March 20th if possible, or at least one week in advance of ordering. This may not be done by phone.
- Bring mid-semester grade reports along when ready to order to verify passing hours for the spring semester only.
- Anyone having failed to leave their name in advance and fail to bring their mid-semester grade report along when ready to order will be asked to return later to allow time for records to be checked.
- All rings must be paid for in full when the order is placed. Senior ring loans are available through Student Financial Aid in the YMCA building.
- Students who do not place their order during this period may order after final grades are posted during May. (Whenever 92 hours have been completed and are on record, there is never a dead-line, except a monthly mailing date on which we send orders to the factory.)
- The ring clerk is on duty from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., each day, Monday through Friday. However in order for other duties to be carried out, no orders will be taken between 11:30 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. or between 4:00 - 5:00 p.m.
- All rings ordered, regardless of whether on March 20th or April 27th, will be delivered on the same day which will be approximately July 18, 1979.
