Missing from this year's line-up are the top three finishers last year: Ongais, Tom Sneva and Gordon Johncock. All have chosen to pass up TWS. Connor says he doesn't mind a bit that Johncock choose to

stay home.
"I could care less if Johncock ever comes back," Connor said. "He choose the race here last August (Texas Grand Prix) to stage a protest of the 4-cylinder engine.

"He got upset when he found out Mario Andretti jumped off to that he had to qualify for the race before he could run in it. So he went on the fourth lap. Gordon out and qualified at 78 m.p.h. And ock took the lead from Foyton that was for an Indy car race.


