



FOR STUDENTS COMPLETING 92 HOURS AT THE END

OF THE SPRING '79 SEMESTER

To be eligible to order the Texas A&M Senior Ring, an undergraduate student must have at least ninety-two (92) semester hours, with 30 hours at A&M and be in good standing with the university. To order at mid-semester using mid-semester grades to fulfill the above requirements, please note the

Students who do not place their order during this period may order after final grades are posted. There will be only a 1-2 week difference in delivery time for those students ordering after final grades are posted during May.
