Doctor says to phase out saccharin use

 WASHINGTON — The chairman of a National Academy of Sciences study on saccharin told Congress Wednesday most of its uses should be phased out and banned after three years unless current food safety laws are relaxed.
 The committee believes that if Congress takes no further action on saccharin, it will eventually be banned under present law by the Food and Drug Administration, said Dr. Frederick Robbins, dean of the medical school at Case Western Reserve University in Cleveland.
 Robbins, a Nobel laureate, headed the study which on March 2 issued a report recommending no immediate ban on saccharin. The report suggested Congress revise food safety laws to make disputes over suspected cancer causing substances easier to decide.
 Robbins told a House health subcommittee it was his personal feeling that if Congress does not have time to revise the food laws then the extensive use of saccharin should be discouraged.

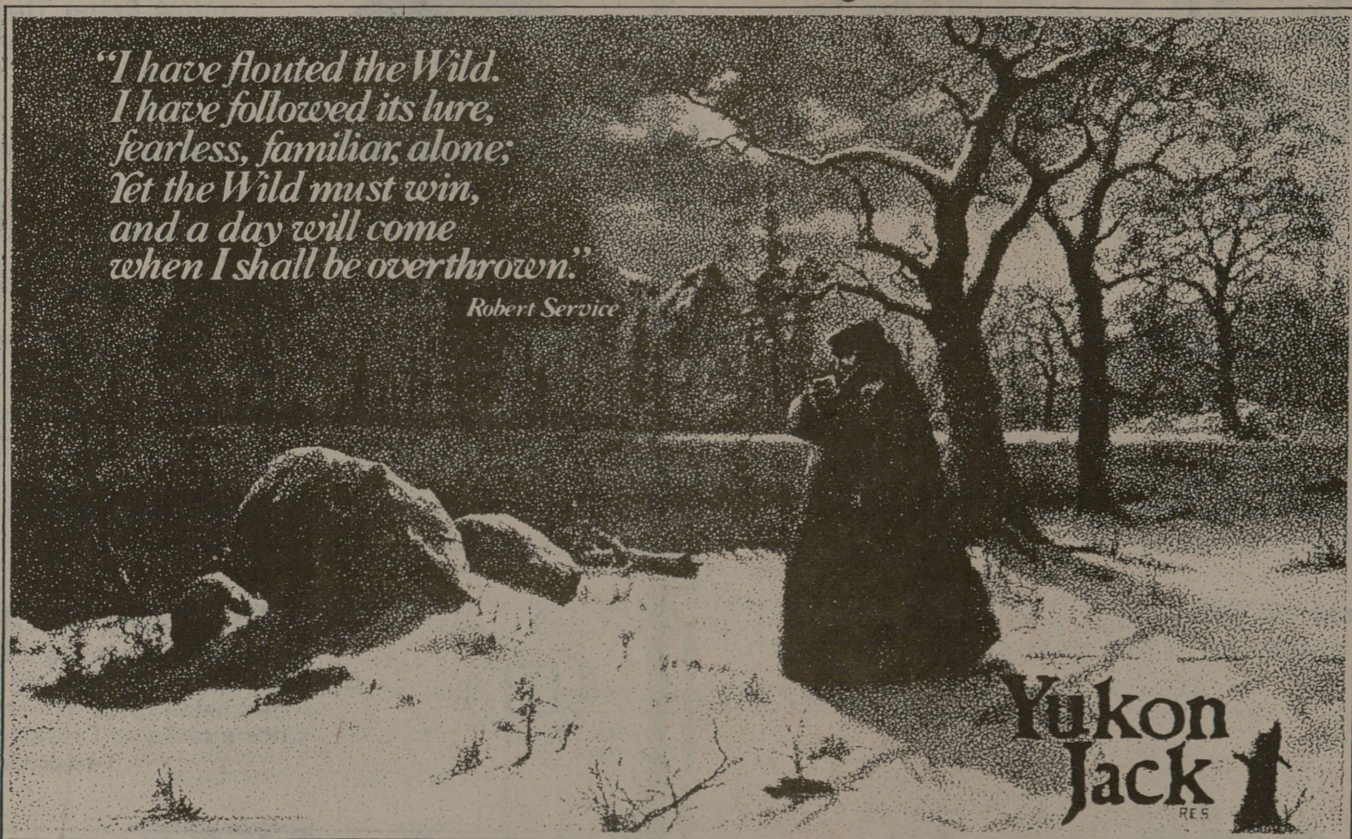
