# Students may dance for charity

The Greek-Independents Dance for muscular dystrophy at Lakeview tonight isn't an ordinary country and western dance. It's a challenge to the Greeks (members of sororities and fraternities) and non-Greeks (independents) to see how much money they can raise together for muscular dystrophy, coordinator Sharon Kuhn said.

The dance is from 8 p.m. to midnight.

Kuhn, a member of Kappa Kappa Gamma sorority at Texas A&M University, said the idea of the dance was to bring all types of students together.

"I get tired of the stereotype that all Greeks do is party, so this way we can incorporate the independents to party with us for a charity cause," Kuhn said.

The dance is sponsored by Kappa Kappa Gamma sorority and Kappa Alpha fraternity. The admission is \$1 per person.

"A lot of thought went into which charity organization to donate the proceeds to," Kuhn said. "Muscular dystrophy was chosen based on the fact that 83 percent of the donations they receive are used for actual medical treatment of the disease and for establishing new research centers around the country."

Kuhn said if 1,000 people come to the dance, Texas A&M will be able to send someone to the Jerry Lewis Telethon next year.

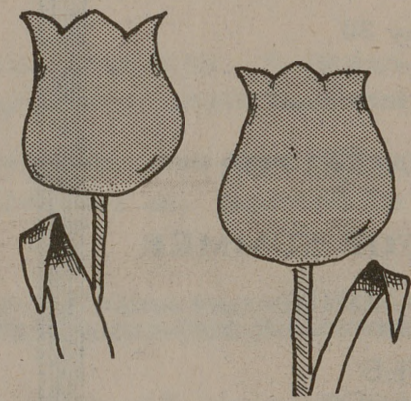

Besides, "Nobody stops a scout car and pets it," says Lt. Muscat, head of the mounted division. Formed in 1893, the mounted division controls traffic in city areas and patrols city parks. The unit's 70 men takes a two-week training course in the riding of his steed.
