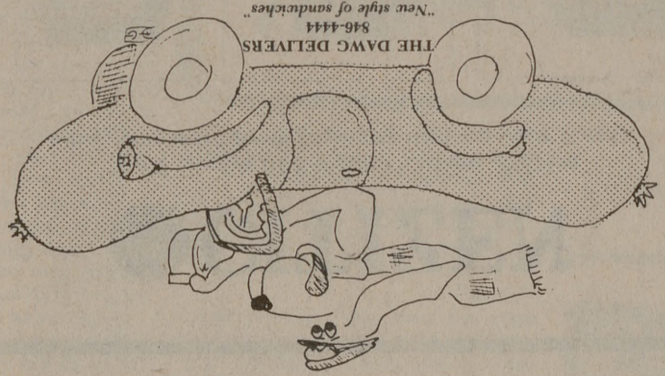
The big plays Ross was referring to behind me out there. "The Texas Aggies locker room."

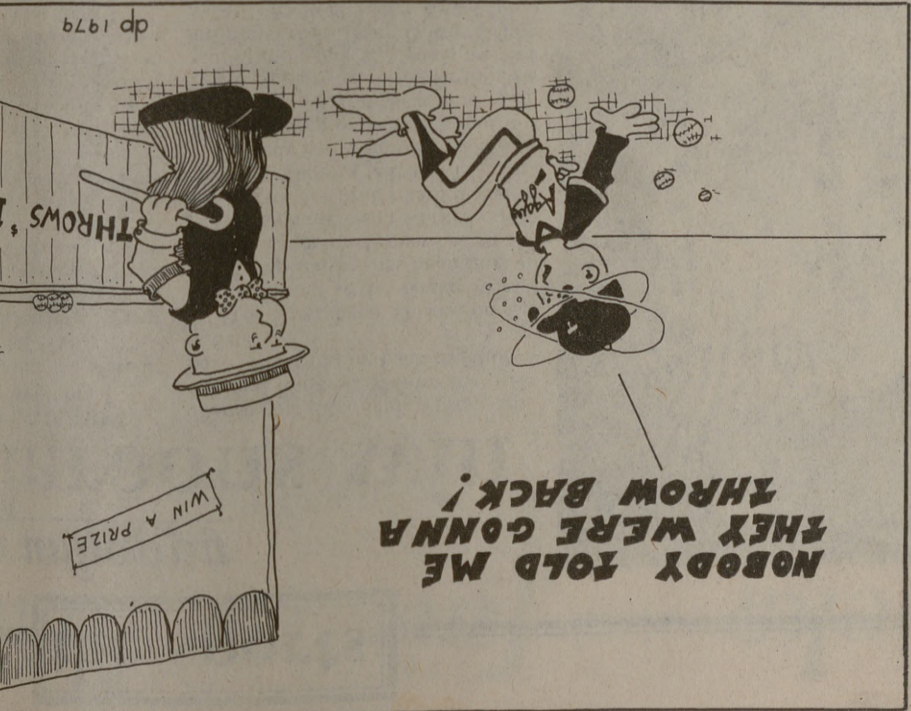
# Ags do well at SWC

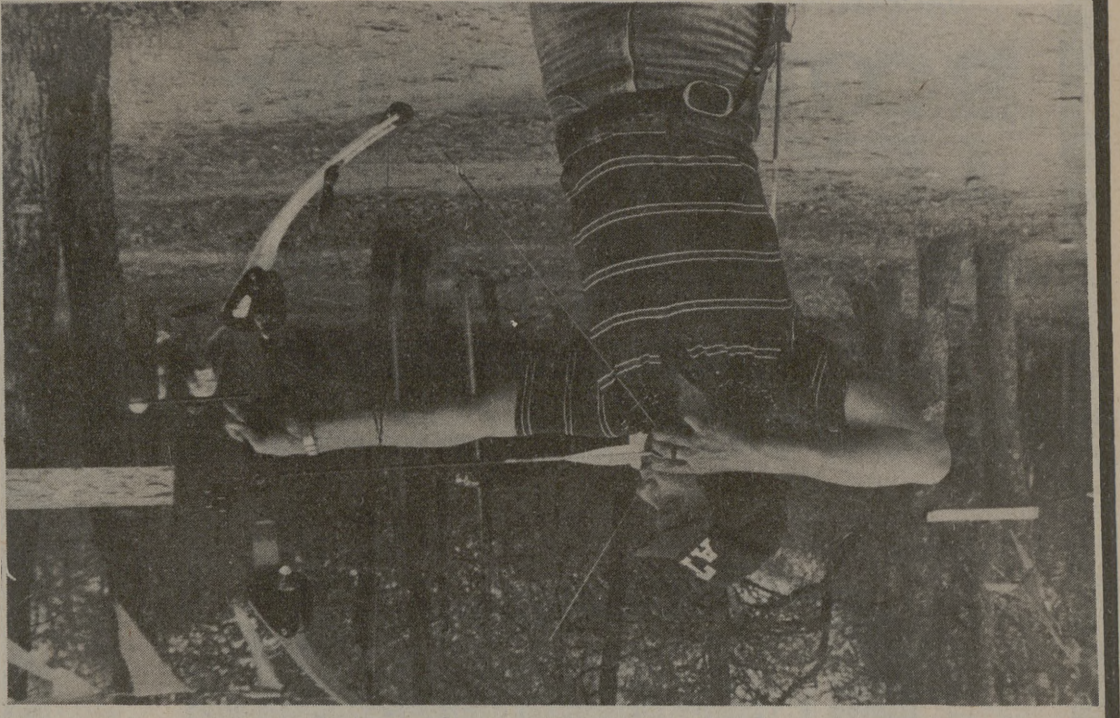

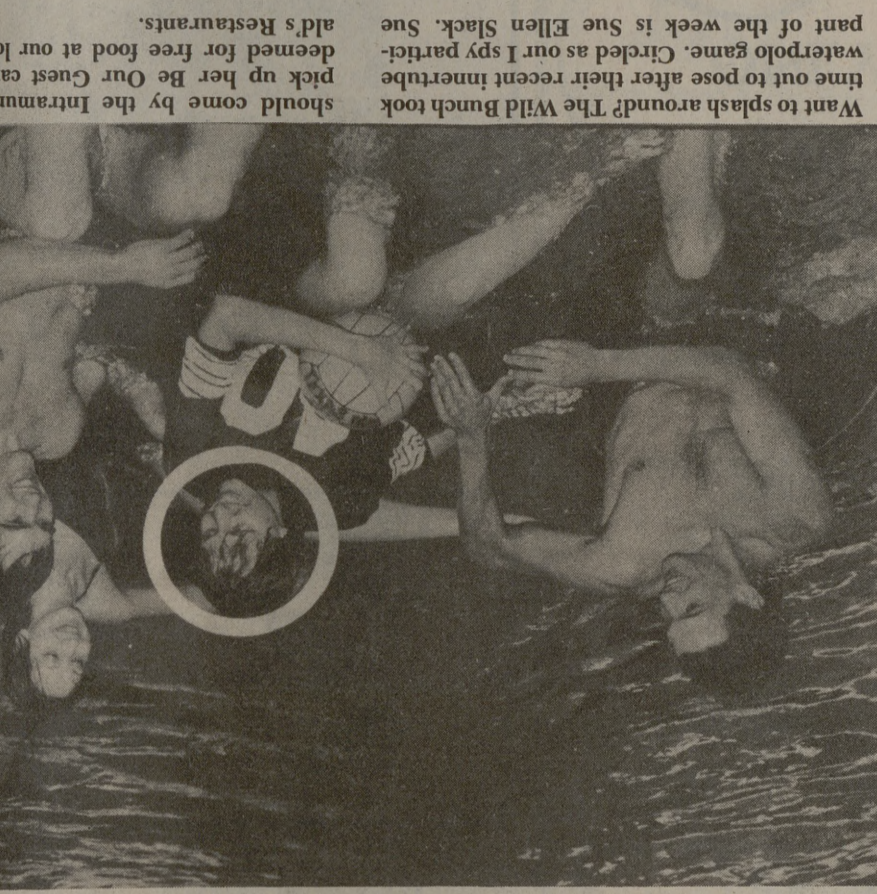
