Our Buy-Back Policy is to buy every college textbook available from the students of Texas A&M University at the time he or she no longer needs or wants to retain them. The bookstore will pay 50% of the current list price on books that are required for the forthcoming school term, (regardless of whether they were bought new or used) unless the store already has an adequate supply.

Used books purchased for resale by the bookstore are sold at 75% of the publisher's list price. If the list price is \$10.00 the used book is sold at \$7.50. In dollars and cents this means:

New Books

Store Selling Price \$10.00
Buy-Back From Student \$ 5.00
50% of payment returned to student.

Used Books

Store Selling Price \$ 7.50
Buy-Back From Student \$ 5.00
66% of payment returned to students.

*This is also a 25% saving at the time of purchase to the student who buys a used book.
