Shah in Mexico City - \$5 plans extended visit

MEXICO CITY — The deposed shah of Iran, his wife, a son and two dogs Monday spent their first day in Mexico behind the walls of a banker's mansion in Cuernavaca, a summer retreat for the wealthy since the time of the Aztecs.

It was the fourth nation Shah Mohammed Reza Pahlavi has visited since leaving turbulent Iran Jan. 19. His arrival in Mexico City caught members of Iran's embassy in Mexico City by surprise.

Sporting a light-colored suit and appearing happy though thin, the shah said upon his arrival from Nassau at Mexico City's International Airport he planned to spend "a few months" in Mexico.

"We have had such pleasant memories of our visit to Mexico," he said, referring to his last visit in May 1975. "We enjoyed so much your beautiful scenery and your hospitality."

The shah, Empress Farah, an 18-year-old son and six other people were immediately whisked off in four dark limousines to the wealthy resort town of Cuernavaca, 50 miles south of Mexico City.

Police sources there confirmed the shah and his party were staying at the white, Spanish colonial-style mansion of Manuel Espinosa Iglesias, president of the private Banco de Comercio and known as one of Mexico's "mega-capitalists."

The shah used Espinosa's sleek white twin-engine Starjet for 2 1/4-hour flight from Nassau.

Police described the shah's accommodations as "very comfortable and secure," complete with a high for privacy.

The shah also owns a large mansion in the town but police said no member of the Iranian family has ever stayed in it.

Only a handful of people were hand to greet the shah when he landed with his family and a French poodle and a Doberman Pinscher — at 4:30 EDT at a private section of the port.

Greeting him were a Mexican military security official and from the government-owned station station, apparently the reporters told in advance of the arrival.

Iran's charge d'affaires in Mexico City, Manoucheher Kazemi, was at the airport earlier Sunday and for Tehran two hours before the shah arrived.

Though the former Iranian monarch had been expected in Mexico since he was granted tourist visa June 1, all reports pointed to Acapulco as his place of exile in the sun and sea in the capital stunned member of the Iranian Embassy.


"You mean he's here, in Mexico City?" said one embassy man who declined to be identified. "I knew he was in Mexico but thought in Acapulco. I've been on the telex to get instructions from my government."

The diplomat said the shah probably will not get involved in the shah's affair — an Iranian court issued a death warrant for the shah and his family — because it is a two-man operation opened in after the shah visited Mexico.

He said if the Iran regime of shah's foe, Ayatollah Ruhollah Khomeini, wants to protest the shah's presence in Mexico it probably do so through the Mexican Embassy in Tehran.


The shah and his family had been living on Paradise island in the Bahamas since March 30. The three youngest children left Bahamas May 26 for California.


