Astros may bid farewell to 'Bull'

NEW YORK — Sometime within the next few days, before Friday's trading deadline, don't be surprised to see Bobby Watson leave the Houston Astros.
He'll be the least surprised if he goes. As a matter of fact, the Astros' low-key, long-ball hitting first

baseman expects to be dealt after 15 years in the Houston organization and will be rather disappointed if he isn't.
His next stop very likely will be with an American League club. Possibly Boston or Texas. Or maybe Kansas City or California. The Yankees also are an outside possibility.

All five clubs are interested in the 33-year-old perennial run producer who has been sitting on the bench doing practically nothing for the past three weeks.
Watson sat down when the Astros brought Cesar Cedeno in from center field to play first base in Atlanta on May 23. The move originally was

supposed to be in the nature of an experiment but Cedeno has made the adjustment so well, he's now the club's regular first baseman.
Chief obstacles in the way of Watson's departure from the Astros are tied in with how much they can get for him and the terms of his contract. An added stumbling block is that any team which gets Watson from the Astros could lose him four months from now because under his present contract he'll be free at the end of this season.

DETROIT — The Detroit Tigers Tuesday fired Manager Sparky Anderson after just 53 games and named Cincinnati skipper Sparky Lyle as his successor.

Tigers' Vice President Campbell said Anderson, who managed for five years, will be in charge of the team's farm system, which is the balance of his one-year contract. "This change is dictated by circumstances," Campbell said. "I regret that things just didn't work out with Les, who earned his way to manage in the major leagues." "But I am glad that Sparky Anderson's capabilities are available at a time when they are necessary."

Anderson was fired as manager last year after which the club won five division titles, four National League titles and two World Series.

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
